

Some things to remember regarding feeding your fish:

- Only feed fish what they can eat in a couple of minutes
- Don't feed fish when it's very hot or very cold

KEEP SAFE



Think about safety around your pond:

- · Use a heavy-duty pond cover.
- Fence the pond area off from young children
- Consider a hidden-reservoir water feature instead

Pond Safety Continued...

- Always wash your hands after putting them in pond water
- Keep a close eye on children when they're near the pond
- Marshy edges & plenty of plants/shrubs around the edge make it more difficult for children to get into deep water
- Always have any electrical equipment installed by a competent electrician
- Use good quality outdoor switches and waterproof connections
- Check cables and equipment regularly & carry out repairs or install replacements as soon as you find a fault
- Install RCD circuit breakers for added protection
- Always switch off electrical items before any maintenance or repair is done
- Carefully read the label on pond treatments & always follow the instructions to the letter
- Store pond treatments & chemicals carefully to keep them out of reach of children

HOW TO GUIDE...

Setting up the perfect Garden Pond

A beautiful Wildlife or Ornamental Pond offers a treat for the senses. Enjoy the sounds, reflections and movement of water, colourful fish, lush plants and help create a haven for wildlife.







The location of your pond is very important:

- Avoid boggy ground, overhanging trees or mains services
- South-facing is good for plants
- Keep it near to the house to enjoy from your window

GET THE RIGHT DEPTH



Get the right depth:

- Avoid your pond getting too hot or too cold
- Shelved edges are saferand suit plants
- A shallow beach area helps wildlife



Replace it when it naturally dissipates:

- A very simple way to add oxygen to the pond is to add an air pump. When the bubbles break the water's surface oxygen will then be added.
- Water features look good and add air which helps the fish.

GET THE LOOK



Think about this when choosing your pond:

- Do you want a formal or natural pond?
- Good quality liners or moulded ponds are essential
- Small garden? What about a freestanding patio pond?
- Ask in store if you need advice on what pond would suit your area.

WATER QUALITY



The quality of your water is important:

- Check water quality using test kits, especially before and after adding fish.
- Pond filters can help keep water clean and healthy

ADDING FISH & PLANTS



Before you buy fish and plants, remember:

- Is your pond big enough for your fully grown fish?
- Don't overstock with too many fish
- Always remember to carefully compost any waste pond plants
