Before You Begin

PLEASE READ ALL INSTRUCTIONS CAREFULLY BEFORE FITTING THE SLEEPTIGHT TO YOUR TEETH.

What you need to begin:

- · Small pot of water and heating source
- · Container to hold about 10 oz of hot water
- Spoon or fork
- Mirror
- Container with about 10 oz of cold water
- Timer

Helpful Tips

- Video instructions are available on our website at dentemp.com/sleeptight
- · Bring the water to a full boil (with large bubbles).
- It may take up to a week to get used to the new dental guard.
- The SleepTight has been designed with a preset jaw advancement to help your snoring right away. Use the SleepTight for 3-7 days to determine its benefit.
- If you still have snoring, you can repeat the fitting process, moving your jaw a little more forward to increase the airway size. Use the fitting handle and follow the original fitting steps.

Installing the Fitting Handle

Holding the mouthpiece with the V-shape notch at the top and the handle opening toward the bottom, make sure the handle is oriented with the long ridge on top. Insert the handle into the opening from the inside arch of the mouthpiece. Push the handle through the opening until the curved end aligns with the arch of the mouthpiece.

Heating

- 1. Bring a small pot of water to a rolling boil, then pour the water into a container.
- 2. Wait 10 seconds, then carefully submerge the SleepTight in the hot water for 2 minutes. Use a spoon to help hold it completely underwater.
- 3. Carefully remove the SleepTight from the hot water to begin fitting. If the edges have folded over, straighten them back into the original horseshoe shape.







Forming

CAUTION: Before placing the SleepTight in your mouth, test its temperature with the tip of your finger. It should be at a warm but comfortable temperature.

- 4. Using a mirror, carefully place the SleepTight on your lower teeth. Make sure that it is centered on your teeth, with the V-shape notch at the top.
- 5. Align upper teeth into the tray and **gently** bite down on the SleepTight. You may need to move your jaw slightly forward. NOTE: Do not clench down excessively.
- 6. Compress all soft material with your fingers against the teeth and gums. Suck in and push the tongue against the sides of the soft material, especially the front upper. Continue until the

SleepTight becomes solid and reaches body temperature.

7. After the SleepTight is firm, place it in the container of cold water for **5 minutes**.

Wear

You should now have a snug, custom-fit SleepTight.

To remove the fitting handle, push the handle in towards the mouthpiece and pull out from the inside of the mouthpiece. If additional fitting is desired, you can follow the same steps. Be sure to keep the handle for possible future refitting.

Cleaning & Care

After each use, rinse your SleepTight with cool running water and a small amount of liquid anti-bacterial soap. Never use hot water. If debris remains, you can use a very soft toothbrush or cotton swab.

Avoid toothpastes containing abrasives, which can damage the soft surface. Never use bleach, alcohol or other strong chemicals.

Weekly soaking with an approved oral appliance cleaner can help with staining and freshness and kill harmful bacteria.
