



## PARTS



>> Begin by assembling the stools.

Take one of each 10" stool panel (1) and (2). Into the right stool panel (1), insert dowl nuts (B) into the holes on the wide sides and wood dowel pegs (C) into the inner holes on the narrow sides. Attach the left stool panel to the right stool panel by inserting bolts through the holes on the outside of the left stool panel.



Now you will attach the stool bottom (3).

Begin by inserting 3 **dowel nuts (B)** into both the right and left stool panels, as shown. Insert **wood dowel pegs (C)** into the holes in the stool bottom that do not go through and through.


Then turn the whole unit upside down and insert 3 **bolts (A)** into the holes in the stool bottom.


In this step you will assemble the stool front.


Line up one of each center, right and left 5" panels (4, 5, and 6) and attach them to each other using 2 hinges (D) and 8 short screws (E).



## **ASSEMBLY**

Now you will attach the set of 5" panels to the stool bottom using 3 long screws (F).






Attaching the **stool top (7)**.

Insert 3 cam locks (I) into the stool sides and 3 cam nuts (J) into the corresponding holes on the stool top. Insert wood dowel pegs (C) into the remaining 2 holes in the stool top.

Make sure that the arrows on the cam locks are facing downwards. To lock each cam lock, turn each one clockwise 90 degrees.



Attach 4 stool pads
(G) using the medium screws
(K).


>> Repeat steps 1-7 for the remaining 3 stools.



>> Now begin assembling the table.

Wedge the **upper table supports (8)** into each other and the **lower table supports (9)** into each other.

Note: the upper table supports have holes along the long edge for connecting to the tabletop; the lower table supports have holes in the center for attaching brackets.






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
Attaching the **table legs (10)** to the table supports.

Note that the holes on the table legs are closer to the edge on one end. This is the end that should connect to the upper table supports. Insert **dowel nuts (B)** into all the holes on the wide side of the table supports. Insert **bolts (A)** into all the holes on the wide sides of the table legs and screw them in.




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Attach the **brackets (H)** on opposite sides of the lower table supports using **short screws (K)**. As mentioned in step 8, the lower table supports have bracket holes in the center.



Now it is time to attach the **tabletop (11)**.

Insert **cam locks (I)** into the holes in both the upper table supports and the tops of the table legs. Make sure that the arrows on the cam locks are facing downwards. Insert **cam nuts (J)** into the corresponding holes on the tabletop. Attach the tabletop to the table support and turn each cam lock clockwise 90 degrees.



You are done! Great job!



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
