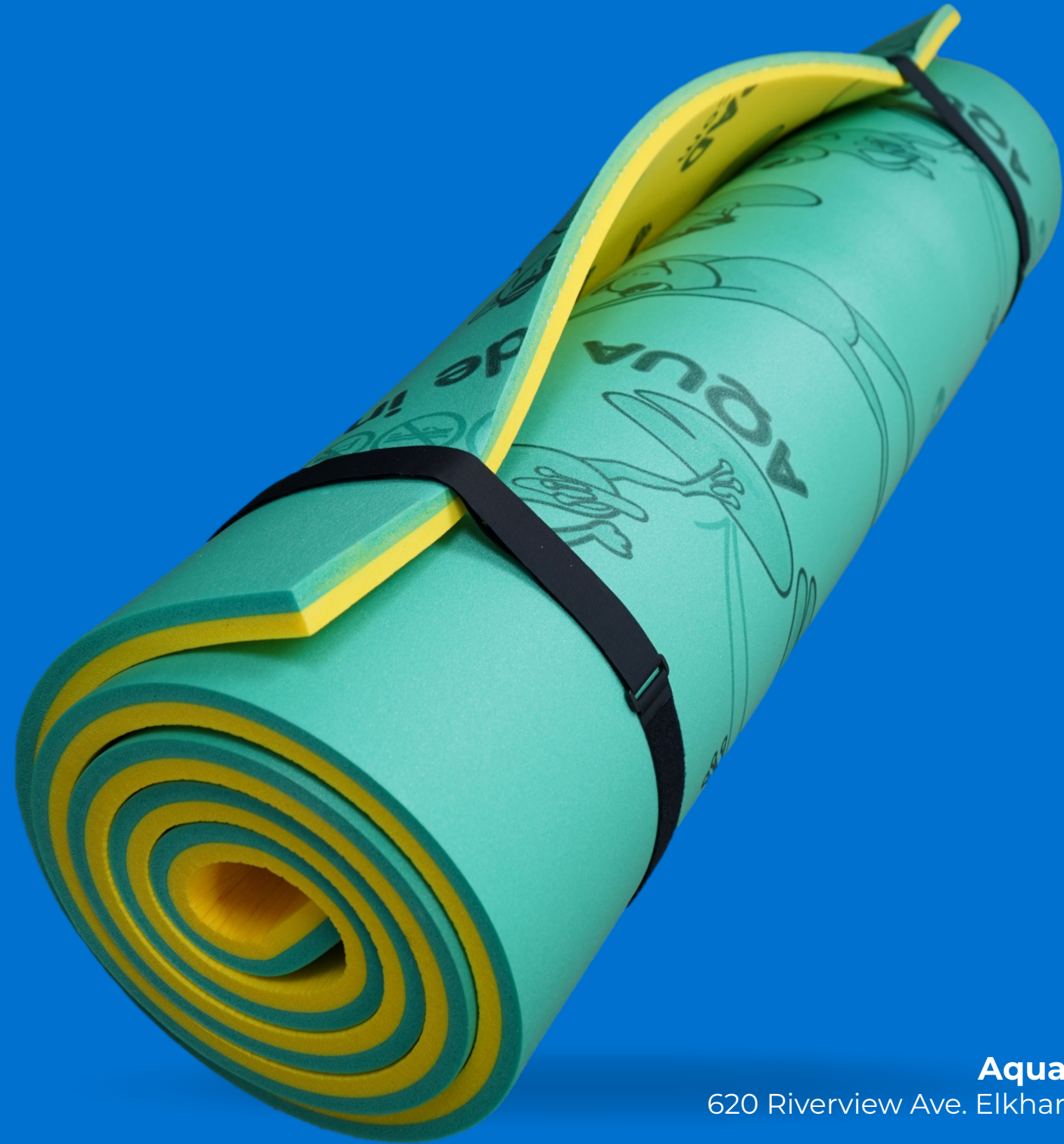

To return the damaged product, please call us at 1-844-669-3820 to obtain a RMA number (Returned Material Authorization). The Foam Water Pad must be shipped back in its original corrugated container along with the clear protective polybag intact.

Owners Manual



When sound judgment is applied, the Foam Water Pad can provide the most unique and enjoyable on-the-water experience. Please note the following list of Operational Precautions for our product. If you have any additional safety concerns or questions, please contact us.



Warning

- The Foam Water Pad is NOT a PFD (Personal Flotation Device). The use of a life jacket is recommended, but is ultimately the responsibility of a parent or each individual adult.
- The Foam Water Pad should NEVER be used in water less than 6 feet deep.
- When jumping onto the Foam Water Pad or engaging in any horseplay, owner assumes all risk and liability, including tears, rips, holes/perforations of the mat, and is not subject to replacement of the Foam Water Pad.
- With continued usage, minor scuffs and surface tears may occur that do not affect the safety and fun of the product.
- The Foam Water Pad should be used in large open areas of water. The beach and lake are the most ideal bodies of water when using all four types of Foam Water Pads.
- Choosing a suitable rafting area as well as considering the size, age and weight of each user is paramount to user safety. Please ensure the area around and below the Foam Water Pad is free of obstructions and debris such as docks, weeds, rocks, logs, rough water and high waves. Also, avoid using the Foam Water Pad(s) nearby/under trees to prevent obstruction with tree branches.
- The Foam Water Pad is not pet-proof; they are not protected against pet chewing and clawing. Use at your own discretion.
- Should pets be placed on the Foam Water Pad(s), they should be supervised at all times. Pet life jackets are also recommended.
- The Foam Water Pad should NEVER be towed, pulled or pushed by any type of motorized vessel at any time. For optimum buoyancy, individual users should not exceed 300 lbs (136 kg).
- Ensure all users are made aware of the tethering-grommet system location when the Foam Water Pad is anchored. The bungee rope and grommet attachment should remain below the playing surface at all times.
- The bright yellow color of the Foam Water Pad does not negate the need to deploy a buoy marking system that is clearly visible to all watercrafts.
- Children should be under adult supervision at all times and accompanied by another user.
- Please consider the water temperature when using the Foam Water Pad. Cold water can profoundly affect breathing, nerves and muscle strength.
- The user must always be in control when on the Foam Water Pad. Do not attempt to board the Foam Water Pad when under the influence of alcohol or drugs.
- Users should never jump or dive off the Foam Water Pad in a headfirst position.
- Never swim under the Foam Water Pad or manoeuvre the Foam Water Pad when beneath the surface.
- Do not board the Foam Water Pad if tired, drowsy or fatigued.
- When not in use, secure the Foam Water Pad against unauthorized or unsupervised use.
- Safely securing and transporting the Foam Water Pad is the responsibility of the consumer. Foam Water Pad is not responsible for ensuring proper fastening devices or the appropriateness of a vehicle utilized or the mode of transport.

Product Longevity



Your Foam Water Pad is made from high density polyethylene foam and will require no air or additional floatation attachments to work. The material is easy to maintain, light weight and set up is painless.

Once the packaging is removed, ensure no foreign materials are situated near the raft that could scratch, mark or tear the material. Wipe the raft clean with water. Before use, inspect the rafts surface for foreign materials and inspect the grommet - tether strap system to ensure proper anchoring is achieved.

Ensure all users remove any jewelry or clothing that could rip, scar or tear the foam surface or edges.

To preserve the rafts surface and vibrant color, reduce direct sunlight exposure for prolonged periods of time. UV rays can damage the rafts foam surface, causing fading. Keep the raft dry and rolled up when not in use.

When storing your Foam Water Pad for long periods of time, allow the surface time to fully dry. Roll up the raft and secure it with the hook and loop straps. Store the raft away from the elements and away from the shoreline.
