## Ordering Uniform

You can buy trousers, shorts, skirts, pullovers, cardigans and socks from any supplier but they must be plain.

All branded uniform marked with \* on the following pages should be ordered from MR Cricket Hockey <http://www.perseschoolkit.co.uk> or purchased instore at The Old Blacksmith's Yard, Burwell CB25 0EA, telephone (01638) 741611. MR Cricket Hockey offer a free delivery service to the Prep every Tuesday for items ordered by the previous Sunday. During the Summer holidays, collection and returns can only be made via the Upper School. All online items are available to try on and purchase at the MR Cricket Hockey shop. They also sell sports equipment.

Please note that all items of uniform and sports kit must be named. We are not prescriptive about the type of name label used (name tapes, permanent markers/sharpies, stickers are all fine). We suggest naming on the inside of clothing (either the collar or rear waist band). MR Cricket Hockey do offer a labelling service.

## Uniform List

School blazer\*

White crested polo shirt\*

Grey V-necked pullover, or cardigan

Plain dark grey trousers, shorts, skirt or grey box pleat tunic

Grey socks (long or short), or grey tights

Alternatively, a "summer" dress\* with plain white socks (long or short)



## Sports Clothing List

School games top\* (winter) and school white cricket shirt\* (summer)

School black shorts\* or skirt\*

School black socks\* (winter) and plain white socks\* (summer)

School black midlayer\*

School black tracksuit bottoms\* (optional) and white cricket trousers\* (optional)



## Other Sports Items

Pupils should wear trainers for PE and Games (Velcro or laced) and, as they become more involved in hockey, may want separate astro-turf trainers. Football boots are also required for those playing football and rugby.

Pupils will need a mouth guard/gum-shield (self-moulding gum-shield from MR Cricket Hockey or dental moulded gum-shields are available) for rugby and hockey and shin pads for hockey and football. These are essential to ensure safe participation in sporting activities.

A boot bag\* is optional but especially useful for football boots.

## Other Items

A cricket sun hat\* or a baseball cap\* or bobble hat\* with the School logo are the recommended headwear.



Children should have a backpack\* with the School logo on.

Outdoor coats can be any colour.

Shoes must be black, of a conventional design and polishable. They can be laced up or Velcro but should not be trainer-type shoes or boots. Any heel should be low-heeled. For safety reasons no open toe shoes or sandals are allowed.
