


GM Gearbox Bearing / Race Remover 08550300

Designed for the removal of large taper bearing races situated in the gearbox housing.

The tool enables the races to be removed in a controlled straight manner whilst spreading the load equally around the bearing housing so as to prevent the housing from cracking.

This tool is for M32, MT 20-6, MT 32-6 F40 gearboxes as commonly found on GM, Saab and Fiat vehicles.





INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Insert puller and engage legs into the two slots under the bearing races (See Fig 1, 2 and 3 for location)
- 2. Place the pulling sleeve over the puller and clear of the race to be pulled (Fig.4)
- 3. Insert force plate between puller force screw and sleeve ensuring dimple faces upwards for screw to centralise (Fig.5)
- 4. Turn force screw with spanner to remove bearing race.

(ENSURE FORCE SCREW IS LUBRICATED WITH GENERAL PURPOSE GREASE / OIL)
