PREPARING FOR INSTALLATION

Raising the Car

- 1. Lift car off ground and secure appropriately
- 2. Remove wheels from vehicle and set aside

Note: Photos show installation of LH side mud flaps

- 1. Remove three (3) visible clips using a Phillips screwdriver to release the center portion of the clip (Reference 01)
- 2. Remove the single lower clip under side skirt (set aside as this will be reused later) (Reference 02)

Note: Photos show installation of LH side mud flaps

- 3. Pull back wheel arch liner
- 4. Position three (3) barrel clips onto the tabs from which the clips were removed

Note: The barrel/threaded portion of the clip should be hidden inside of the fender. (Reference 03)

A pick tool can be helpful to align the barrel nut to the hole. (Reference 04)

- 5. Replace wheel arch liner making sure it tucks underneath the fender (Reference 05)
- 6. Position the bracket so that the stepped bent tab is closest to the outside of the vehicle and the lower tab feeds between the wheel arch liner and the side skirt
- Secure bracket to vehicle over the wheel arch liner by using an M6x16 screw and washer and attaching to the lowest positioned barrel clip (Reference 06)

- 8. Secure a barrel clip to the bracket over the inside hole (Reference 07)
- Resecure the lower clip under the side skirt through the mounting bracket be sure to secure all three pieces
 together. Note: If you struggle with this step a "X-Mas" tree clip can be substituted

- 10. The mud flap can now be installed to the bracket. For the inner most mount use the remaining M6x16 screw and washer. For the top two mounts use the M6x20 screws and washers. Secure all hardware so that it is tight but does not drastically deform the flap. Use of anti-seize recommended for salty/corrosive environments. (Reference 08)
- Repeat steps 1-10 to install the mud flap on the opposite side
- 12. Reinstall wheels and make sure lugs have been set to the appropriate torque

REAR MUD FLAP INSTALLATION

Liner Disassembly and Flap Install

- 1. Remove two (2) visible clips using a pick tool or flathead screwdriver (Reference 09)
- 2. Remove forward most clip from underneath vehicle connecting the painted bumper to the wheel arch liner (set aside as this will be reused later) (Reference 10)
- 3. Pull back outer splash guard to expose the middle mounting location position a barrel clip over this hole Note: Make sure to position the barrel clip in the correct orientation. (Reference 11 + 12)

REAR MUD FLAP INSTALLATION

- 4. Replace wheel arch liner making sure it tucks underneath the fender (Reference 13)
- 5. Prepare rear bracket by positioning one barrel nut clip on the top part of the bracket (Reference 14)
 - Note: Make sure the arc in the bracket matches the wheel arch
- 6. Position the bracket between the liner and the painted bumper (Reference 15)
- 7. Place a barrel clip over bottom hole making sure to capture the painted bumper with the bracket (Reference 16)

 Note: The clip may need to be opened slightly for this step for ease of installation. A pick tool can be helpful to align the barrel

REAR MUD FLAP INSTALLATION

- 8. Resecure clip to the underside holding the painted bumper to the wheel arch
- 9. Mud flaps are now ready to install
- 10. Use M6x16 screw for the top mount to the bracket. Use three (3) M6x20 screws for the bottom three mounts. (Reference 17)

The innermost mount will be secured on the opposite side with the provided M6x1 locking nut and washer. (Reference 18)


Note: Secure all hardware so that it is tight but does not drastically deform the flap. Use of anti-seize recommended for salty/corrosive environments.

- 11. Repeat steps 1-9 to install the mud flap on the opposite side
- 12. Reinstall wheels and make sure lugs have been set to the appropriate torque
- 13. Safely lower vehicle


