

How to Apply The Couture Collection Gilding Waxes

All natural Gilding Wax is available in 10 colors: *Black Velvet, Gold Lame', Bronze Brocade, Copper Charmeuse, Silver Taffeta, Pink Cashmere, Blue Organza, Green Moiré, White Silk and Gunmetal Tulle.*

This wax is designed to add special effects, metallic sparkle or depth to furniture or cabinets. It can be layered to create multiple color combinations, for example use Copper Charmeuse, then add some Green Moiré to create a Patina effect!

Gilding Wax can be applied over any of our The Couture Collection products. It is especially effective when applied over raised embellished areas or details on furniture. If your piece does not have any embellished areas you can create them using the Embossing Medium and a stencil.

Apply Gilding Wax with your finger or a small artist brush. This should be the last layer you apply. If you are using Glaze Couture or Lacquer Couture apply Gilding Wax AFTER those steps. The Gilding Wax will dry to the touch in 4 hours and fully cure in 4 days. It can be buffed to a sheen; this is usually done the next day with a soft lint free rag.

Hardware such as knobs and pulls can also be enhanced with Gilding Wax. Best results are achieved on ornate pieces rather than smooth metal hardware. If you want to apply it to smooth hardware, we recommend slightly roughing the piece up with sandpaper and painting one coat of Paint Couture! on it, then use the Gilding Wax.

Clean your fingers or brushes with coconut oil. Gilding Wax has no odor and no solvents.
