## How to create LACE with Embossing Medium

Embossing Medium is an opaque acrylic plaster that is used to create three dimensional effects and texture on furniture and cabinets. This product has great adhesion capabilities and can be used directly over Paint Couture!, wood, or most previously painted surfaces. If the surface is very shiny lightly rough it up with 220 grit sandpaper.

### *Lace Effect:*

- 1) Using the Behr Bellagio trowel or scraper (plastic or metal) apply a thin layer of Embossing Medium over the surface you would like to cover.
- 2) Lay down the lace on top of this thin layer and secure with tacks.
- 3) Place some Embossing Medium on your trowel and spread starting in the middle of your lace working outwards in all directions. Pull off excess embossing medium with the trowel so you can see the lace pattern.
- 4) Let it sit for about an hour (in dry environments about 1/2 hour).
- 5) Pull off your lace slowly to reveal the pattern. Let dry, then lightly sand if needed.
- 6) Paint or glaze as desired. Seal it with Lacquer Couture!<sup>TM</sup>

Note: You can also tint the Embossing Medium so the lace will be a color!
