

Avistria Olive Oils are among the Top Performers at NYIOOC 2023 with 7 Gold Medals

The New York International Olive Oil Competition, the world's largest competition for olive oils in the top quality category "Extra Virgin" set a new participation record in 2023 with 1,100 olive oils submitted from 23 countries.

With a success rate of almost 68%, 531 gold and 216 silver medals were recorded.

Avistria, the newcomer in the segment of top oils from Istria, won gold medals for all 7 products submitted at this year's NYIOOC.

Due to this huge success, the country of origin Croatia was also able to move up significantly in the national ranking and is now only one medal behind the olive oil giant Spain in 3rd place overall!

The top 6 countries have the following medal table: Italy (174), Spain (106), Croatia (105), Greece (90), USA (80) and Turkey (74).

Among the Croatian participants, Avistria was able to secure first place with its 7 gold medals, followed by one participant with 4 gold medals and 2 participants with 3 gold medals each.

The focus of Avistria products is on autochthonous Istrian varieties, but also increasingly on various, rarely spicy Italian varieties. It is produced strictly according to the rules of the "Codex Avistriae", the quality management system of the Avistria olive plantation.

The Avistria Group is 100% Austrian family-owned, the plantation in Sveti Lovrec/Istria currently covers around 35 hectares with around 400 old and over 9,000 young olive trees of various Istrian and Italian varieties.
