

Doing so will void the warranty of this product.




OPERATION



OPERATION (CONTINUED)


The light is equipped with a stand that can be adjusted freely by loosening and tightening the knobs on the sides of the light.

2. To adjust the light and stand, loosen both knobs by turning them in a counterclockwise manner (Fig 2). To tighten the knobs, turn clockwise (Fig 3).




The light can either be supported by the adjustable stand or hung by it.

3. The light can be supported by the scissor stand and the light can be aimed by rotating the light head (Fig 4). The light head can be rotated up to 360°.



4. Both legs of the scissor stand can fully rotate 360° (Fig 5). The light can also be hung by the legs (Fig 6).



CLEANING INSTRUCTIONS

Using a soft cloth, clean the fixture using a mild, non-abrasive glass cleaner. DO NOT use solvents. DO NOT use cleaners containing abrasive agents. NEVER spray liquid cleaner directly onto the light or LED.

TROUBLESHOOTING GUIDE

Problem	Probable Cause	Solution
Light does not turn on.	 Switch is off. Not plugged in. Light malfunction. 	 Turn on switch. Plug cord in. E-mail info@stonepointledlighting.com.
Circuit breaker trips or fuse blows when light is turned on.	Discontinue use immediately.	1. Call an electrician.
Stand will not stay up.	Knobs are not tight. Stand legs are too close together.	Tighten knobs. Re-adjust position of stand legs.
