

Welcome to Suzuki Plaza

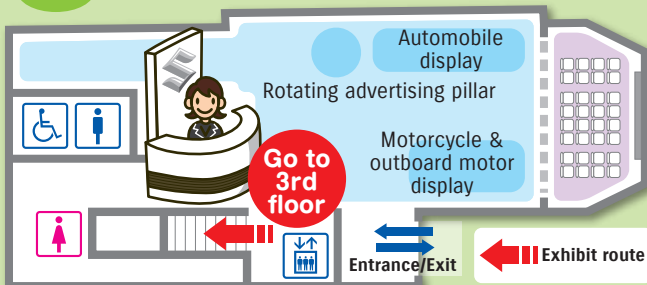

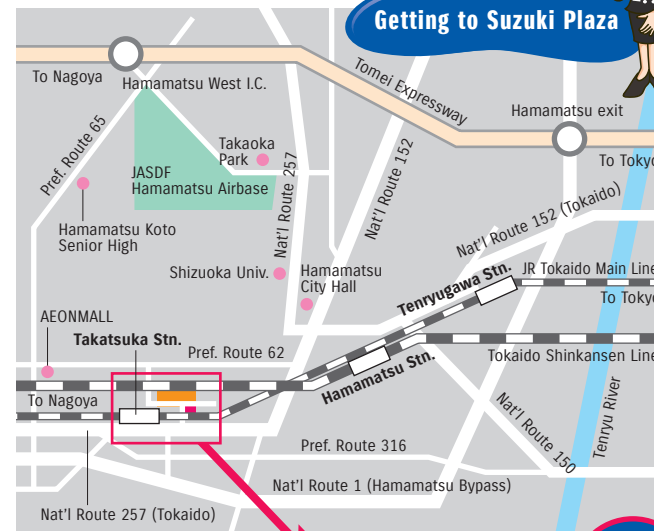
Visits to Suzuki Plaza are by reservation.

- **Tours:** Self-guided

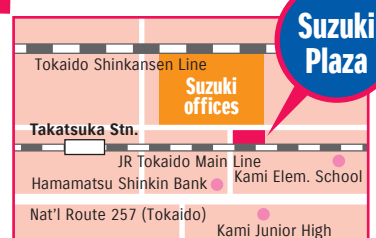


Getting to Suzuki Plaza

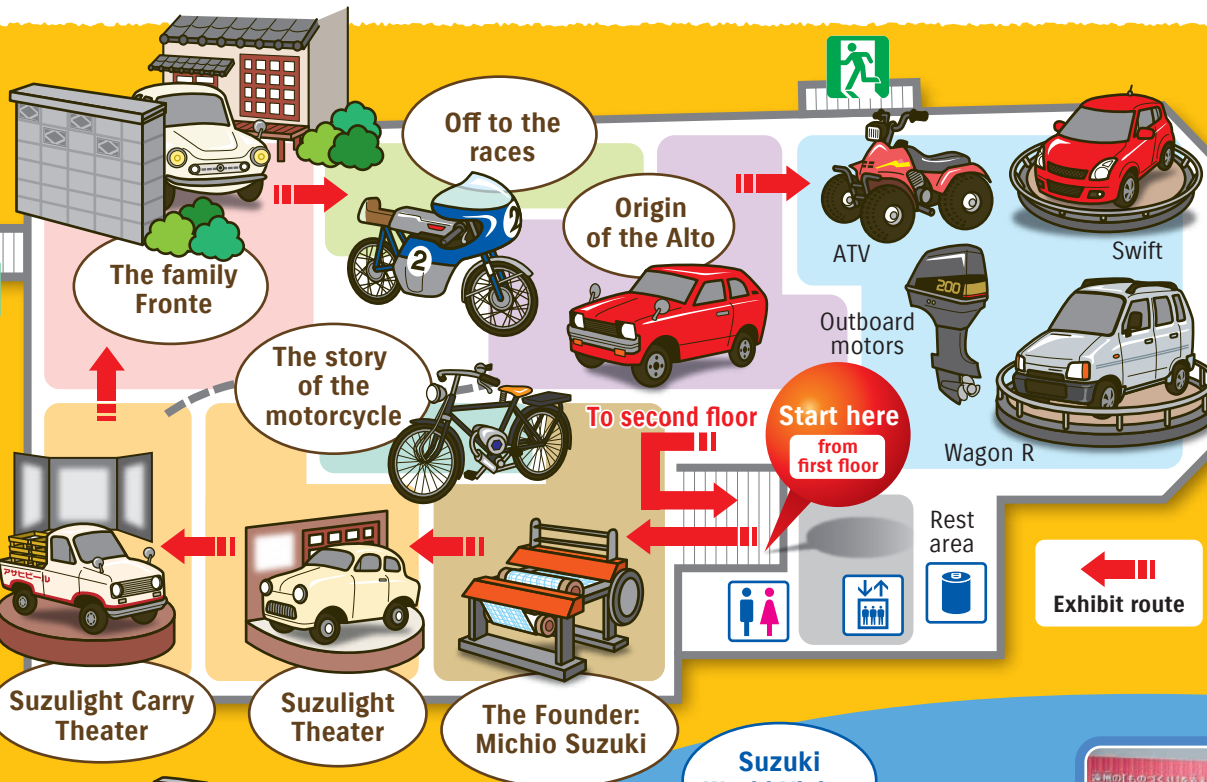
