Thank you so much for your magnificent work on my SIG P-226. I have always liked the SIG pistol but it is rather "crunchy" as it comes from the box. Working on the SIG action, I am told, is quite tricky, not at all as easy as slicking up a Smith revolver or tuning a Colt 1911. Your action job on the German service pistol is nothing short of fantastic. I didn't think it possible to get the "grittiness" out, but you really slicked up the action and reduced the pull considerably. Double-action is now butter-smooth and the single-action is crisp and light.

I also appreciated the other custom touches to improve the pistol's function, such as that mirror-bright polish on the feedramp and the trigger bar gouging on the frame. I don't know, but I imagine the re-crowned barrel should group better as well.

Thanks again for taking the time to work on my pistol. I will certainly mention your fine services to my readers as I have every confidence in your abilities and talents. (Besides, you're a Texan!)
