

Alka Bottle - Manual

Prepare the Filter:

- Open the bottle, remove the filter from its bag.
- Soak the filter in clean water for 5 minutes.
- Shake it and rinse under tap water.

Install the Filter:

- Open the bottom cap by turning it clockwise.
- Place the rinsed filter into the cap's ring, ensuring the O-ring is properly seated to prevent leaks.
- Reattach the bottom cap tightly to the bottle.

Clean the Bottle:


- Fill the bottle with drinking water, then seal it.
- Shake well and discard the water.

Set the Filter Life Indicator:

Numbers 1-12 on the bottle's



bottom represent the months; each has 4 marks for weeks. Point the triangle to the current month and week. Change the filter roughly every 2 months or after 100 liters.

Filling the Bottle:

• Use only clean, safe water. The bottle reduces chlorine and some chemicals, not bacteria or other specific contaminants.

Activate the Water:

• Shake the bottle 5-7 times, then wait a few minutes. This enriches the water with minerals and makes it alkaline.

Usage Tips:

- Drink the alkaline water within 12-24 hours to avoid a too strong taste.
- Avoid hot water and dishwashers to prevent damage.
- Clean with warm water, mild detergent, or vinegar without the filter.

Leak Troubleshooting:

 If you notice any leaking, first check that the silicone seal is correctly aligned in the bottom groove and that both top and bottom caps are tightly secured. Note that the bottom cap has more threads than the top cap, indicating a specific direction for each. Misalignment or reversing the caps could cause leaks.
