

## Fluoride Free Benchtop Add-on

### Filter Order Matters:

- Place the Active Pure Filter (a carbon and KDF filter) before the FluorEx Max to prevent clogging. This setup ensures the FluorEx Max can effectively remove fluoride without interference from other chemicals.

### Flow Rate:

- Keep the water flow at or below 1.5 liters per minute. If it fills a cup in less than 5 seconds, the flow is too fast for the filters to work efficiently. Only use cold water in the system.

### Using Your Tap:

- Turning the tap lever vertically lets water flow into the sink. Moving it horizontally diverts water through the filters.

### Prep and Flush:

Flush the Active Pure Filter before installing the FluorEx Max to avoid carbon fines from clogging the latter.

After installing both filters, flush about 4 liters through the system to clean it before use.

Following these steps carefully will protect your equipment and ensure optimal filtration performance.
