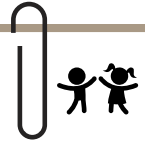


Community Helpers

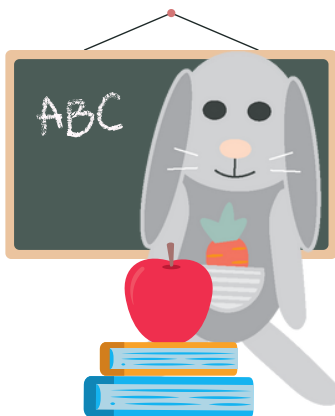
