Presented in partnership with the Discovery Museum in Acton, this interactive area blends science, creativity, games, and live performance for a full-sensory experience tailored to young festivalgoers.

Hands-on exhibits from the Discovery Museum and Inventor STEM School invite curious minds to dive into the wonders of science and engineering. The Lowell Chess Club will be on hand with boards ready for play. Additional activity tables hosted by community partners provide even more opportunities for kids to explore, create, and connect.

Anchoring the Playspace is a dedicated performance area at the corner of Merrimack and Central Streets, featuring a lineup of youth performances and family-friendly acts throughout the weekend. It's a joyful space where kids can not only watch and listen—but jump in and be part of the fun.
