# **Fitting instructions** for a DAVOSA rubber watchstrap

Fitting your DAVOSA rubber watchstrap is a simple six-step process.

# You will need the following:



- Your DAVOSA watch
- DAVOSA rubber watchstrap with two suitable spring bars
- A suitable DAVOSA buckle with two suitable spring bars
- DAVOSA strap changing tool
- a measuring tape, use the one below
- · Cutting tool
- Optional:
  A pair of pliers or tweezers

# Release the spring bars

Press the spring bars together at the lug to release the strap from the case.

# Attach the watchstrap

Insert the spring bars into the openings provided on the lug end of each watch-strap section.



A. Push the strap with the spring bar into the opening on one side.



B. Push the spring in and slide the spring bar into the opening on the other side.

### Measure your wrist diameter


Use the DAVOSA size guide (below) for this purpose.

# Determine length of watchstrap





Measure your watch with the watchstrap attached and add the length of the buckle.

## Shorten the watchstrap accordingly



Calculate the difference using your measurement from step 3. and shorten the strap equally on both sides. If you are uncertain, leave the strap a little longer at first, and shorten it further if needed.

# Attach the buckle to the watchstrap







Make sure that the logos on the buckle and the watch are correctly aligned. This will ensure that the buckle is fitted the right way round.
