The Fine Print

Warranty

As described in and as limited by this Warranty, Pop-A-Shot Enterprise, LLC (the "Company") warrants this product to be free from defects in workmanship and materials for a period of 90 days from the date of original purchase. The term defects shall mean any imperfections that impair the use of the product. The company reserves the right to request confirmation of proof of purchase when requesting parts or service in order to confirm that this product is within its warranty period and terms.

What is Covered:

Just about everything, but mainly defects in materials and workmanship. This warranty is void if the product is:

- Damaged through improper usage or storage, negligence, misuse, abuse, transportation damage, acts of nature, or accident (including failure to follow the instructions supplied with the product).
- Used in commercial applications, rentals or a commercial environment.
- Modified or repaired by anyone not authorized by the company.

What the Company Will Pay For:

- If any part or component of the product which is covered by this warranty is found by the company to be defective, the company will provide replacement parts without charge. The company's obligation to repair or replace the product or any portion of thereof, shall be limited to the original purchase price of the product.
- If during the warranty period, the product is found to be defective, the company will, at the company's option, repair, replace or make remuneration for the product (either the same or equivalent value) without charge.

To Obtain Warranty Service:

- You must return the original copy of your sales receipt to the company showing a purchase from an authorized retailer.
- You must email the company's customer service department at support@popashot.net to notify the company of the nature of the problem. Customer service is available Monday through Friday between the hours of 8:00am and 5:00 P.M. CST. At the company's option, replacement parts or a new product (either the same or equivalent value) will be sent to you at no charge.
- If you are instructed to return the product to the company for servicing, you are responsible for shipping the product, at your expense, to the address designated by the company in packaging that will protect against further damage.
- You must also include your name, address, daytime telephone number, product model number, and a description of the problem.
- The company will pay for any shipping charges to return the repaired or replaced product to you.

STEP 1

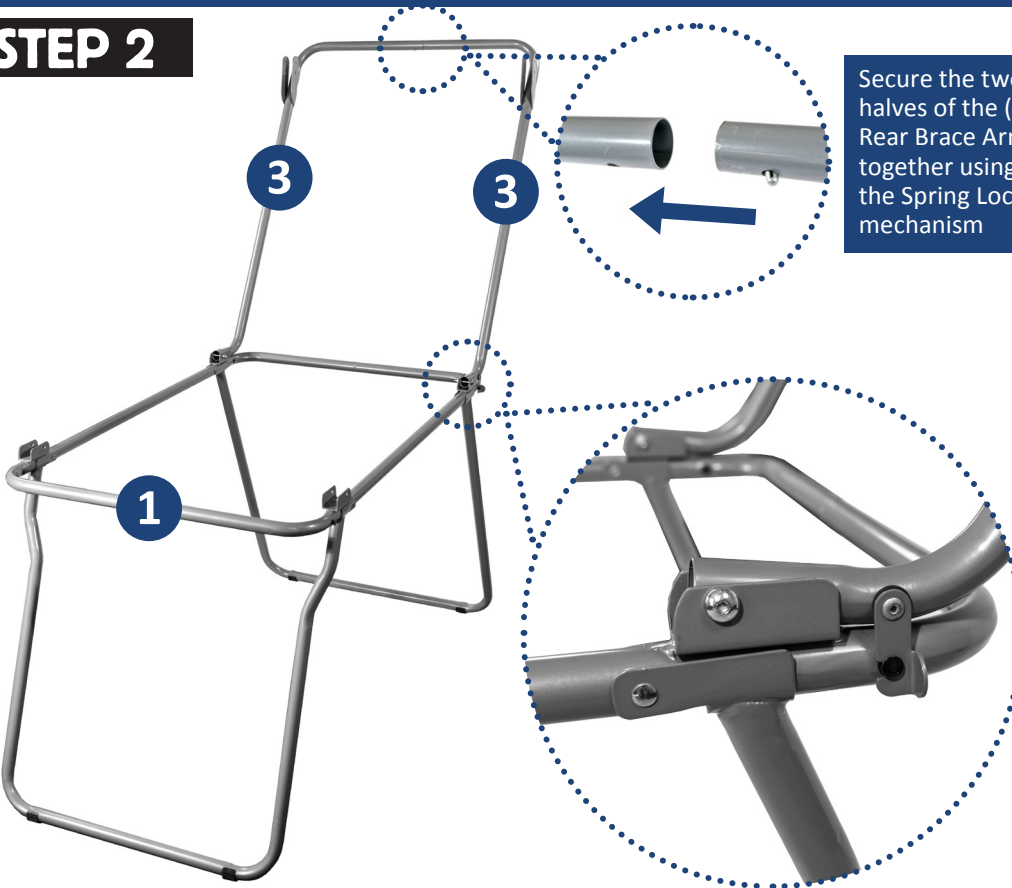
ID#	Name	Qty.
1	Base Frame	x1

Unfold the legs of the (#1) Base Frame and fully extend them until the frame can stand on its own. The legs that bow inward should be in the front.

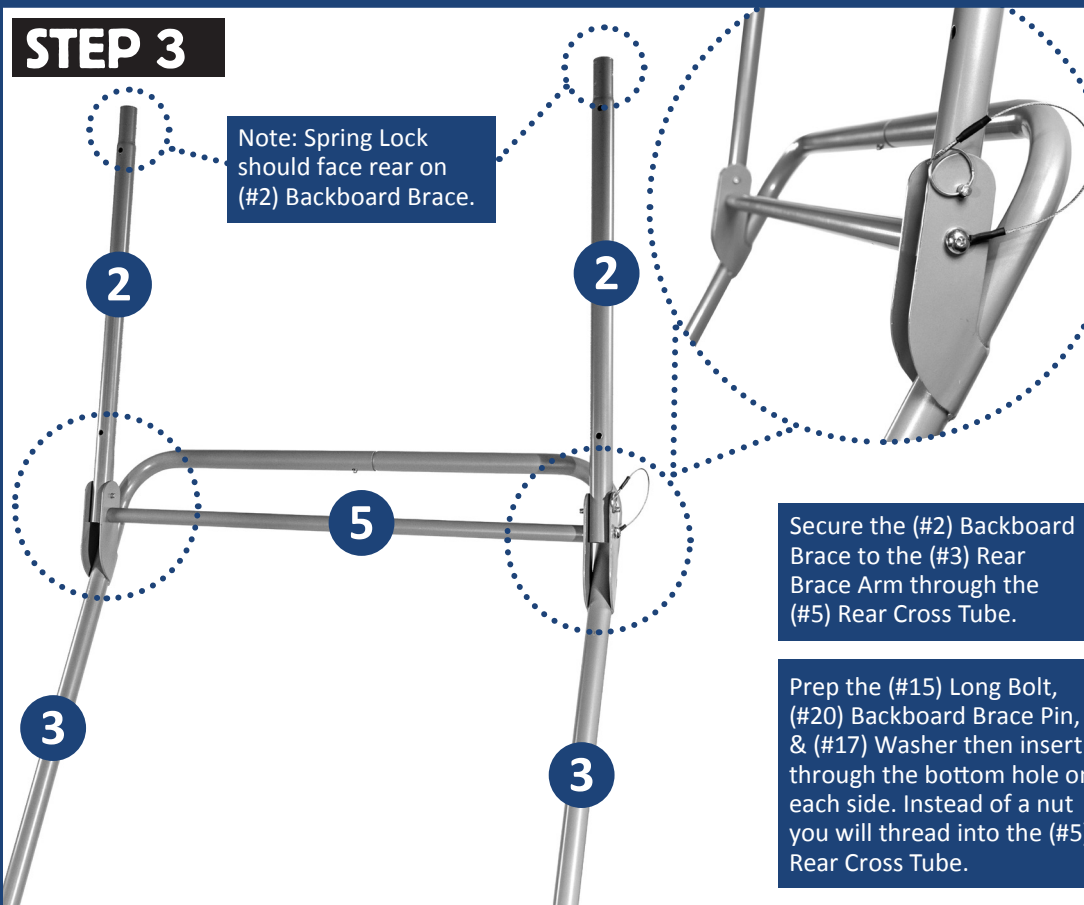
Secure the two halves of the (#3) Rear Brace Arm together using the Spring Lock mechanism

Then attach the (#3) Rear Brace Arm to the (#1) Base Frame using a (#15) Long Bolt, one (#17) Washer on each side & (#18) Nut. Stabilize by latching the gray clips on the side of (#3) Rear Brace Arms to the (#1) Base Frame.

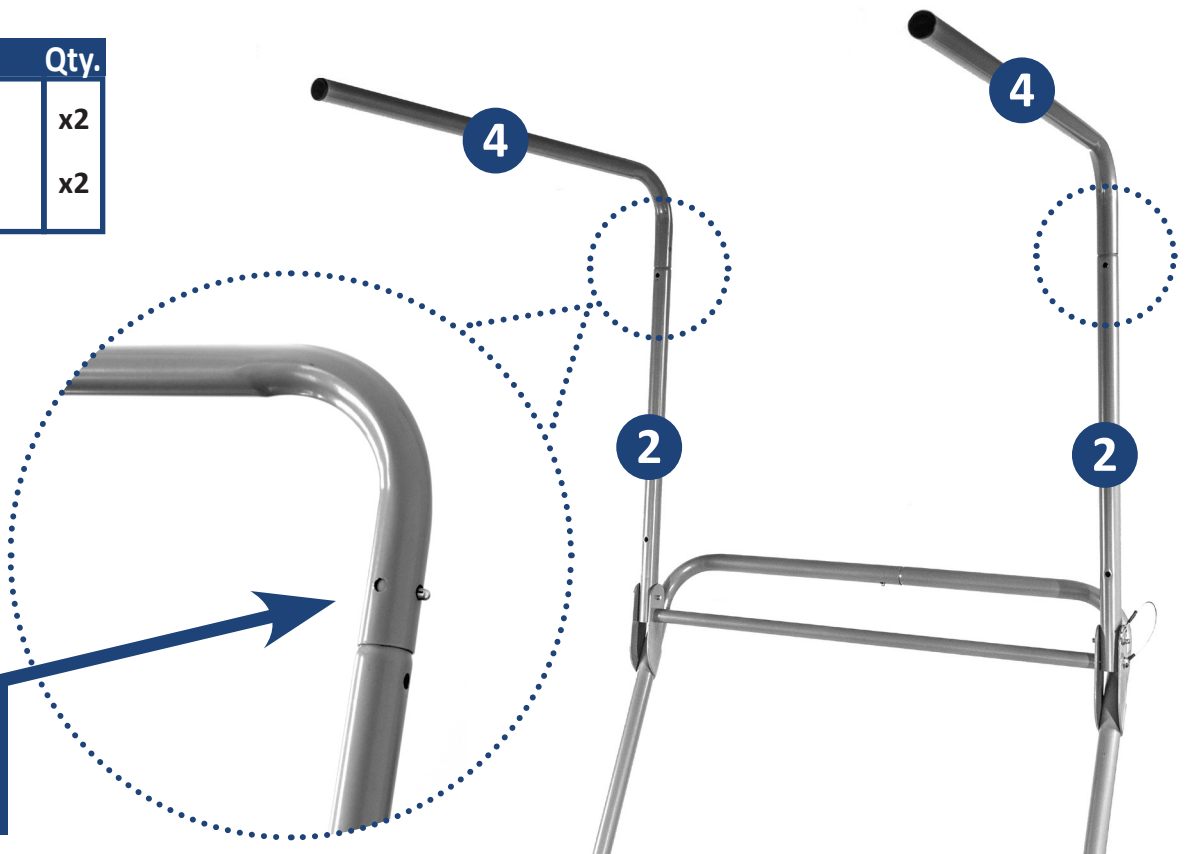

Attach each (#4) Top Tube to each vertical (#2) Backboard Brace piece using the Spring Lock mechanism.

Note: The holes on the inside of each of the (#4) Top Tubes should both face in toward each other.

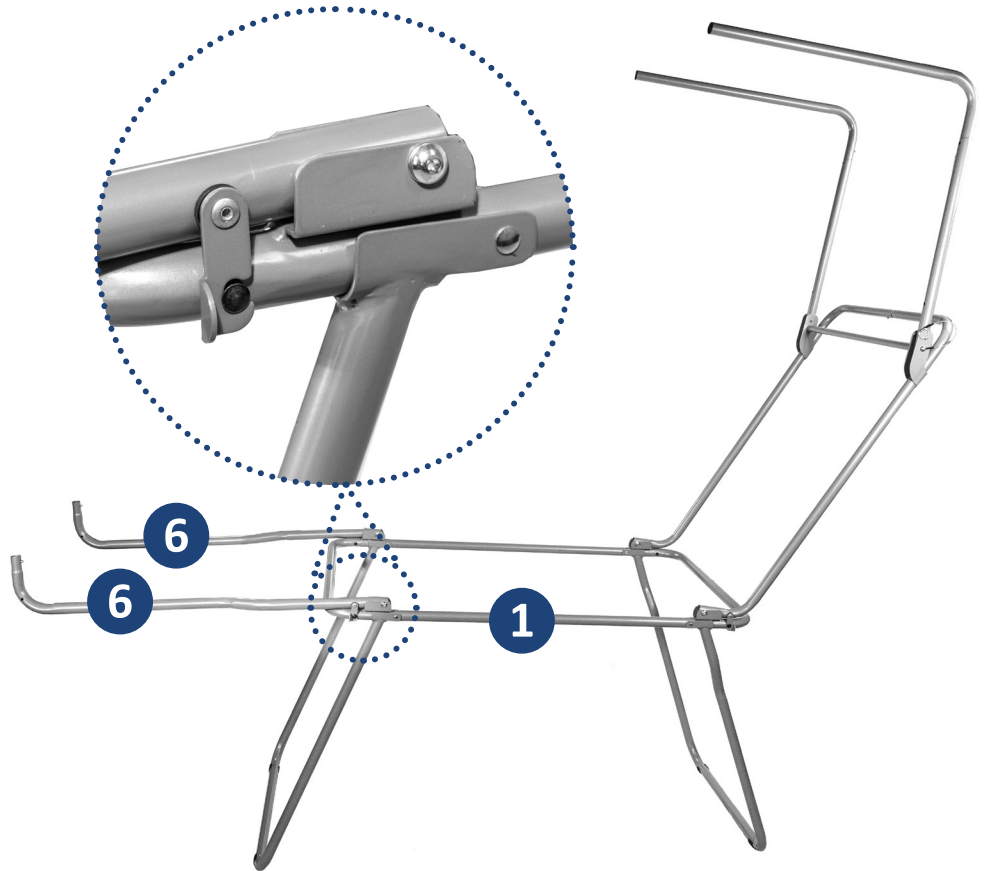

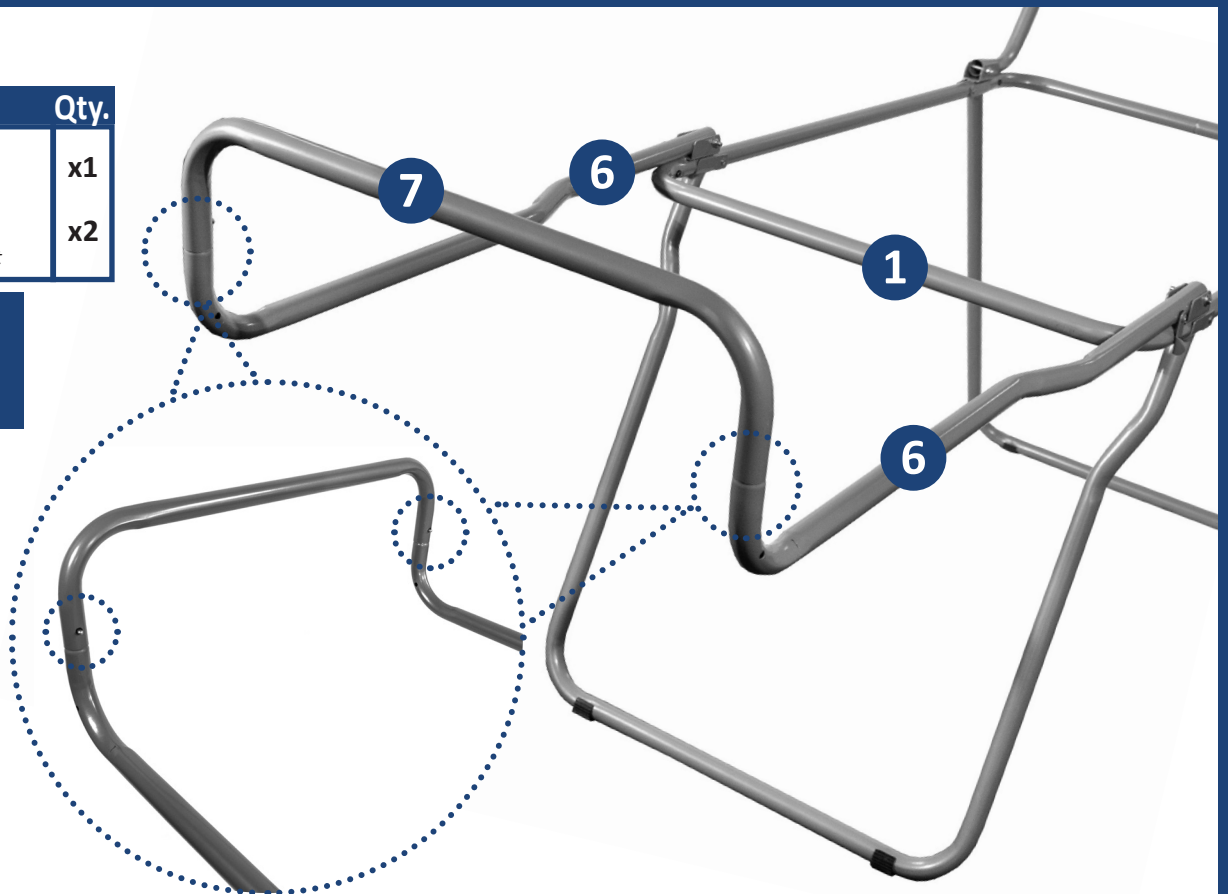
Attach the (#6) Front Arm Tube to the front of the (#1) Base Frame using a (#15) Long Bolt, one (#17) Washer on each side & (#18) Nut. Both tubes should narrow toward the center of the game when attached properly. Stabilize by latching the gray clips on the side of (#6) Front Arm Tube to the (#1) Base Frame.

7	Lean Bar	x1
6	Front Arm Tube <i>Left & Right</i>	x2

Secure the (#7) Lean Bar to the (#6) Front Arm Tubes using the Spring Lock mechanism.



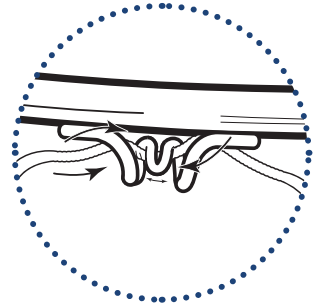
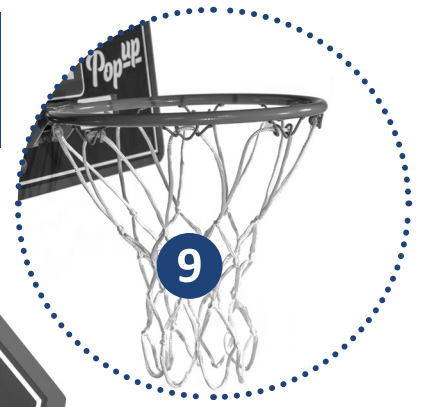
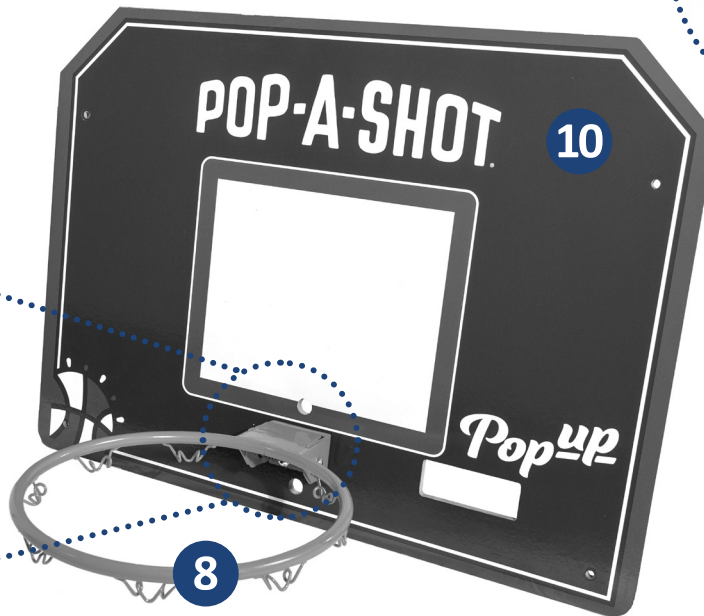
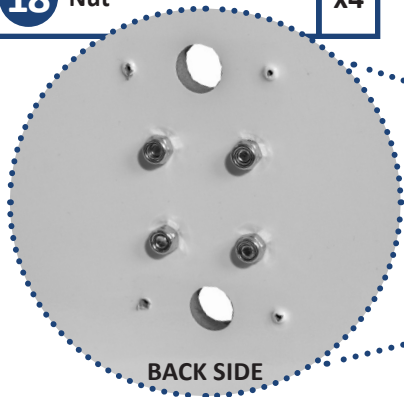

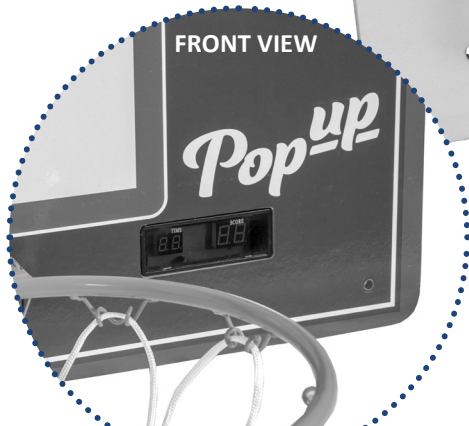
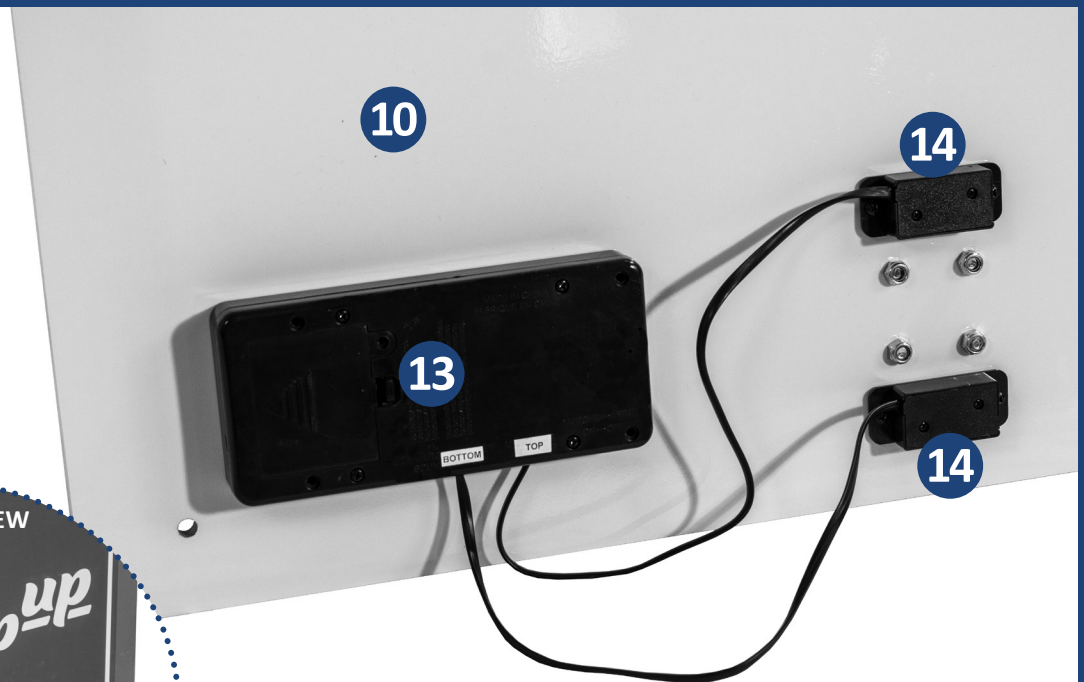
Attach the (#8) Rim to the (#10) Backboard using a (#16) Short Bolt, one (#17) Washer on each side & (#18) Nut. After installing the (#8) Rim, attach the (#9) Net, making sure the longer strands are on top.

Note: If the net is not attached properly, scoring can be affected.

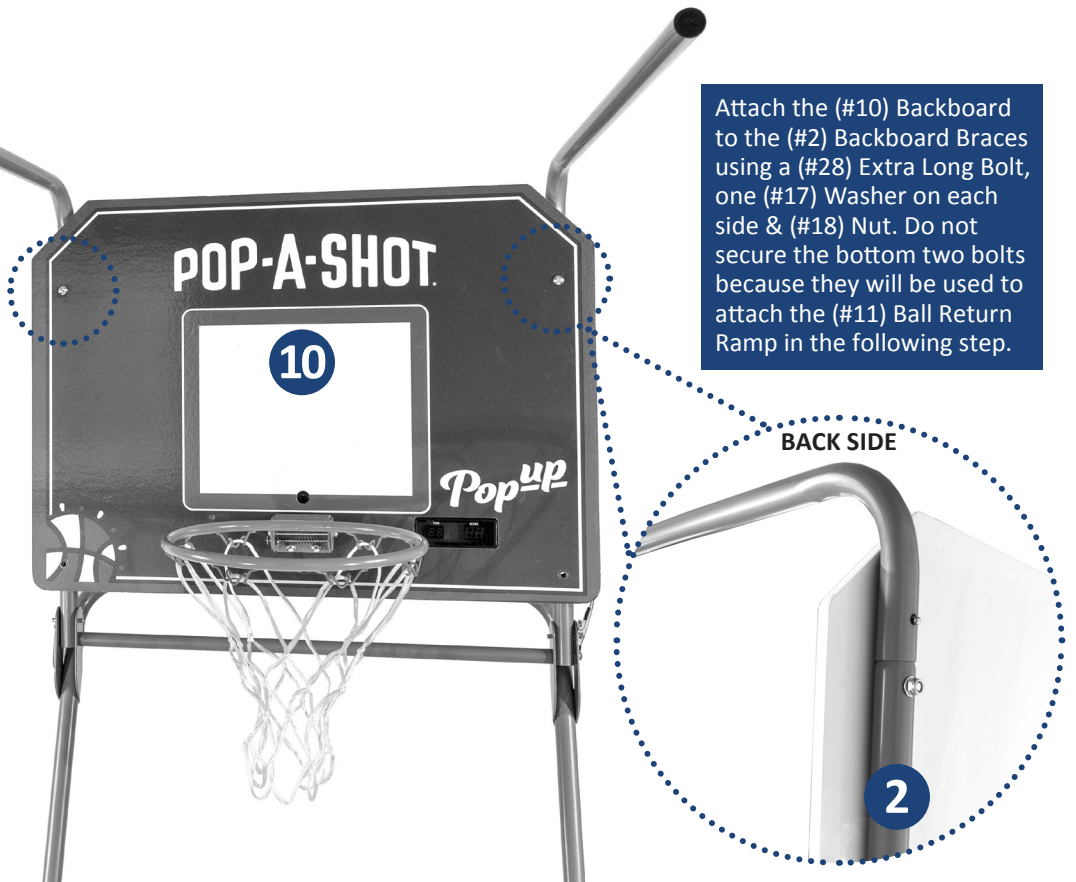
Place 3 AA batteries (not included) in the (#13) Scoreboard. Attach the (#13) Scoreboard to the rear of the (#10) Backboard using (#25) Medium Screws. Attach the (#14) Sensors to the (#10) Backboard using the (#19) Small Screws. Plug the (#14) Sensors into the proper top and bottom ports in the (#13) Scoreboard.

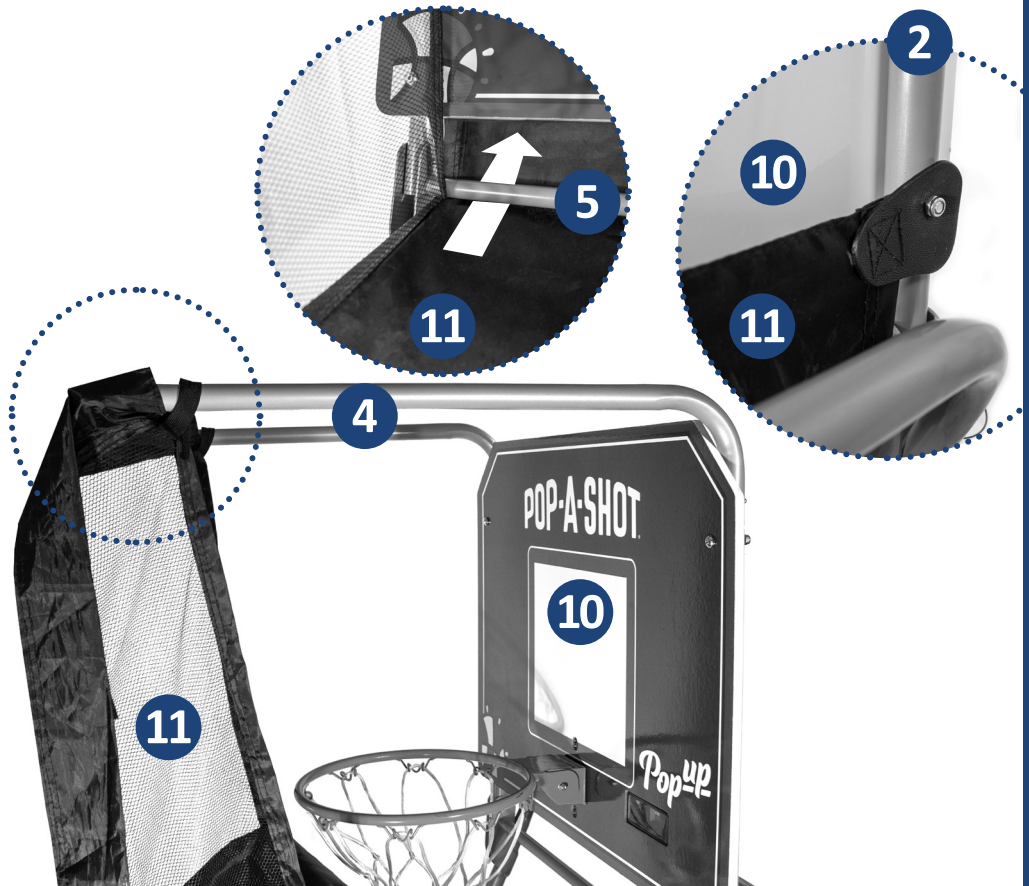
Attach the (#10) Backboard to the (#2) Backboard Braces using a (#28) Extra Long Bolt, one (#17) Washer on each side & (#18) Nut. Do not secure the bottom two bolts because they will be used to attach the (#11) Ball Return Ramp in the following step.

4	Top Tube <i>Left & Right</i>	x2
10	Backboard	x1
11	Ball Return Ramp	x1
28	Extra Long Bolt	x2

Slide the (#11) Ball Return Ramp sleeves over each (#4) Top Tube and attach the Plastic Tabs from the (#11) Ball Return Ramp to the rear of the bottom holes of the (#10) Backboard and (#2) Backboard Brace using the (#28) Extra Long Bolt, one (#17) Washer on each side & (#18) Nut. The (#11) Ball Return Ramp should be pulled behind the (#5) Rear Cross Tube before it is attached to the bottom of the (#10) Backboard.

HOW TO PLAY :30

- Flip switch to "ON" on the bottom rear of the scoreboard.
- Baskets are 2 points until final 0:10 when they are 3 points.
- Bonus: 0:15 extra at 30 points
- 0:10 extra at 60 points.
- Shoot another basket to start an additional game.
- Game will hibernate if not played for 5 minutes and requires a reset.

READY TO PLAY!

Slide the (#12) Front Cross Tube through the pocket in the front of the (#11) Ball Return Ramp and secure the (#12) Front Cross Tube to the (#6) Front Arm Tube tubes using a (#27) Medium Bolt, one (#17) Washer on each side & (#18) Nut. Fasten the (#11) Ball Return Ramp hook and loop straps to the (#7) Lean Bar.

Note: If there is too much tension, fold the front of the game toward the middle to create slack.

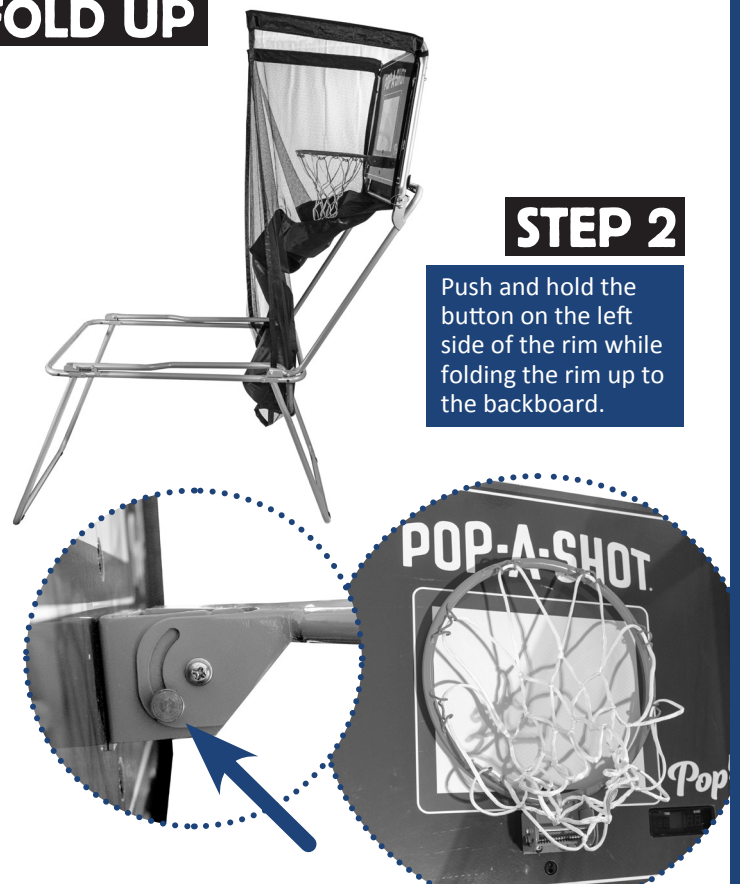


HOW TO FOLD UP



STEP 1

Unlock all four gray locking clips and fold the front of the game toward the center.



STEP 2

Push and hold the button on the left side of the rim while folding the rim up to the backboard.

STEP 3

HOW TO FOLD UP (Continued)

STEP 4



Push in the spring locks on the rear of the top tubes and turn each toward the inside of the game. These should lock into this new position using the spring locks.



Remove the locking pins from the backboard brace and then fold the backboard down toward the center of the game.

Fold the remaining backboard section toward the middle, then fold the legs under the game, Front Legs first.



Place the folded game into the included bag and you are good to go!

Use the folding instructions in reverse to set up your game and you are ready to play!
