

# FESTIVE TRIVET



## FESTIVE TRIVET

**DIFFICULTY:** Easy

**NUMBER OF SQUARES:** 8 **FINISHED SIZE:** 10" X 10"

**YARN:** Brown Sheep Nature Spun, worsted, Ash, 32 yards; Red Fox, 32 yards.

**EQUIPMENT:** Zoom Loom, 6" weaving needle. 3" tapestry needle

**WEAVING:** Weave 4 squares each of Ash and Red Fox leaving one long tail for sewing.

**ASSEMBLY:** Lay the squares flat, in an overlapping "pinwheel" pattern, while alternating colors. Using the tail from the previous square (for example, red square on top, use the ash tail) sew a straight stitch, securing each square to each other. Once all squares are attached, flip over and check that all the laps are tacked down and secure. **FINISHING:** Wash in hot water with a small amount of dish soap, alternating with cold water, to full slightly. Press out excess water. Lay flat to dry.
