The battery is not fully charged and it is highly recommended that you charge the headset before you begin using it.


Note: Using ABCTVKIT "out of the box" will not harm the device. You will experience reduced battery life as the unit will not be fully charged.

Charging the headphones

Connect the larger USB end of the provided cable to your computer / power adapter (not included). Connect the smaller USB end to the USB port on the bottom right side of the heaphones. Please charge the battery for a minimum of 2 hours. The red LED will be on while charging. The light will turn blue when it is fully charged.



Bluetooth Headphones - Device Operation (using with other devices)

Pairing with devices such as an iPhone, smartphone, and tablet:

The pairing procedure will vary depending on the actual device. Please refer to the user guide of your device for detail instruction. The pairing procedures are as follows:

- 1. Make sure the headphones are powered off.
- 2. Power on the headphones and it will enter pairing mode automatically. (Red and Blue LED will flash rapidly)
- 3. Activate your device's Bluetooth function and set your device to search for Bluetooth devices. Select ABCDMKITH when it is found.
- 5. If prompted by your device to connect, please select "Yes".
- 6. After connecting successfully, the blue LED will flash every 10 seconds.

Note: Please make sure the audio output is set to Bluetooth for audio streaming from the device.
