

AFTER CARE INSTRUCTIONS

Congratulations and thank you for purchasing a Genie Stove.

Genie stoves need very little maintenance. However if you want to ensure season after season of relaxing evenings around the fire, we suggest you follow these basic care tips.

1. Choose the Right Fuels

Kiln dried hardwoods, such as oak, birch, beech, hornbeam and harder softwoods, such as juniper and cedar, are the best fuel for your fire pit.

See the FUEL section of our website for a full range of fully tested and great value for money products you can use in your Genie Stove, delivered directly to your door.

*Wet or damp wood will create a smoky flame, as well as make your fire pit harder to clean. For the best flame, we recommend burning Oak, Birch, Alder or Juniper firewood.

Be careful when using wood pellets in your fire pit, as the pellets can fall into the ash pan and block the airflow to the fire.

2. After Use

Once your fire has gone out, make sure it is cool to touch. (Dispose of hot ash carefully). Use the Genie Lid to secure the ash in your stove as it cools. Brush cooled ash in the stove into the ash pan below (through the holes at the bottom of your stove. Then lifting the stove off the ash pan/stand, you can dispose of the ash in a compost heap or ash bin. Or you can use an ash vacuum (available from most hardware stores) to clean out your ash pan.

*Treat your stove with respect. Do not bang your stove off the side of a bin or other container to dislodge ash. This WILL damage your stove. Then, we recommend you store your fire pit in a cool, dry location.

3. "Patina" Is Normal

After a few uses do not worry about the gold and blue hue that may appear on the outside of your stove. This is completely normal for these to emerge on your fire pit after a handful of burns. We call it the "patina."

The patina is caused by the fire pit's 304 stainless steel reacting to the intense heat generated inside your fire pit, but be assured it does not affect its performance.

4. Cover When Stored Outdoors

If you plan on storing your fire pit outdoors, we recommend covering your fire pit when it's not in use. A little moisture on the outside of your fire pit is okay as long as you dry it off with a towel. However, moisture can damage the grate and ash-pan inside your fire pit.

We recommend using the Genie Carry/Cover Bag with your stove to keep it safe from the elements. The Genie Carry Bag is made from material which protects it.

Planning on leaving your fire pit in one spot just for the night? The Genie Lid is the perfect temporary cover option for your fire pit. Once the fire has died down and your fire pit is cool to the touch, top your fire pit with the Genie Lid and you can safely call it a night!

5. Wood, Trex or Composite Decking

If you want to use your fire pit on a deck (wood, composite, or Trex), stained concrete, grass, or any other heat-sensitive surface, we highly recommend using the patio base stands or the Genie Pizza Oven base stand. These products have been specially designed to pack inside the stove for storage and when in use, to fully protect your heat sensitive surfaces from the heat of your Genie Stove.

If you do not have a Genie Stove Patio Stand, or the Pizza Oven, you can use a concrete slab or similar to place your Genie Stove on before lighting.

By following these simple care instructions, your Genie Stove fire pit will burn more efficiently and cleanly, and remain in top shape for a lifetime of enjoyment around a hot, roaring fire.

6. Your Account

When you purchased your Genie, you were given the option to check out as a guest or create a customer account.
