

giornata 2020 Aglianico French Camp Vineyard

Inspired by Italy - Crafted in California

AGLIANICO: Originating from southern Italy, this grape stands up to the bold and spicy flavors of the region. Our block of Aglianico at French Camp Vineyard thrives in one of the warmest sections of the Paso Robles AVA. Nevertheless, it is often the last fruit to be picked in any given harvest, it ripens slowly, and retains beautiful freshness and acidity at relatively low sugars. Thick-skinned and intense, its brooding dark fruit dominates flavors produced early in fermentation. As the intensity subsides, floral and nuanced spice aromas emerge.

TASTING NOTE: Aromas of violet, dried blueberries, vanilla and sand. This rendition of Aglianico is full but not overbearing, with a lingering finish. The palate balances the sweeter impressions suggested by the aroma with loads of tannin, leather and spice.
