Manual Brake Pad Gage Brake Pad Gages



→ What do the color different colors represent?

• Green blades mean the brakes are still good, yellow blades mean the brakes should be serviced soon and the red blades mean the brakes must be serviced

→ What callouts are on the tool?

• The tool is marked with both metric and SAE callouts

→ What type of brake pads can this tool be used with?

• This tool can be used with both disc and drum brake pads

→ What range of blades are available?

• There are (8) blades, ranging from 2mm (0.0787") up to 12mm (0.4724")

→ What is the material the gauges are made from?

• The material of this tool is anodized aluminum

→ Can you use this tool to check the brake pads with the tires on?

 Depends if the rims have enough space to see both the rotor and brake caliper, but if not you have to remove the wheel

→ What are the dimensions of the unit?

• Dimensions : 5" x 1.31" x 0.50"
