# Manual Brake Pad Gage

## Brake Pad Gages

### → What do the color different colors represent?

- Green blades mean the brakes are still good, yellow blades mean the brakes should be serviced soon and the red blades mean the brakes must be serviced

### → What callouts are on the tool?

- The tool is marked with both metric and SAE callouts

### → What type of brake pads can this tool be used with?

- This tool can be used with both disc and drum brake pads

### → What range of blades are available?

- There are (8) blades, ranging from 2mm (0.0787") up to 12mm (0.4724")

### → What is the material the gauges are made from?

- The material of this tool is anodized aluminum

### → Can you use this tool to check the brake pads with the tires on?

- Depends if the rims have enough space to see both the rotor and brake caliper, but if not you have to remove the wheel

### → What are the dimensions of the unit?

- Dimensions : 5" x 1.31" x 0.50"
