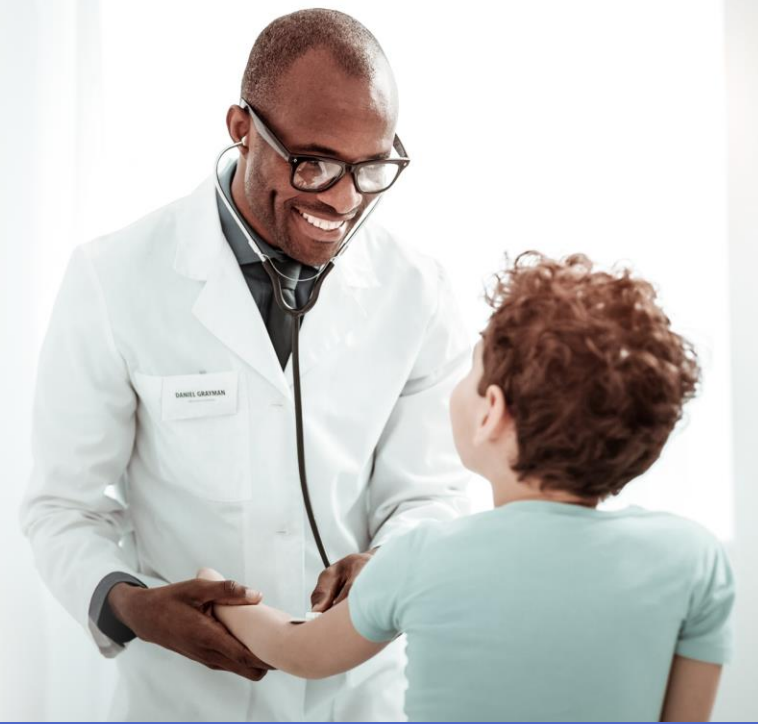


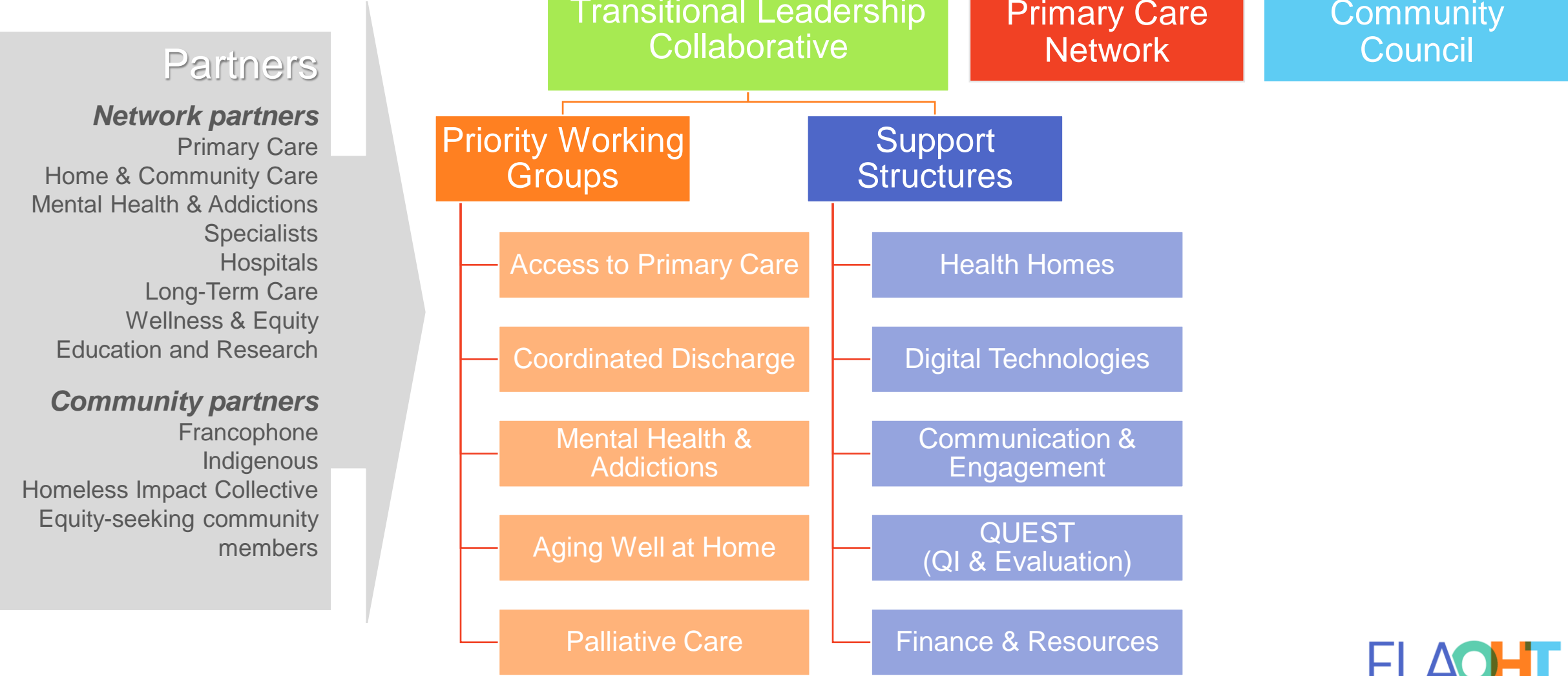

Transitional Leadership Collaborative

- Comprised of co-chairs of each of the Networks, Support Structures and Community Council
- Operates on a collaborative decision-making model

Primary Care Network

- Comprised of primary care providers who work together on challenges and improvements in health and wellness delivery
- Primary care providers are family physicians and nurse practitioners
- There are about 160 primary care physicians in the Frontenac, Lennox and Addington regions and all are partners of the FLA OHT

FLA OHT Organizational Structure ~ explained

Community Council

- Comprised of community members from diverse backgrounds, who provide their lived and living experience and advocate for the health and wellness system:
 - French-speaking community members
 - Indigenous community members
 - Patients/Clients with lived experience
 - Care partners / Family members / Caregivers
 - Citizens
- Participate in co-design with Priority Working Groups and Support Structures
