
INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS FOR DIRECT BURIAL MAILBOX POSTS




- 1. CONSULT WITH LOCAL AUTHORITIES AS TO SPECIFIC CODES. THE FOLLOWING STEPS SHOULD HELP YOU MEET THOSE CODES.
- 2. EXCAVATE A HOLE APPROXIMATELY 20" DEEP OR DEEPER DEPENDING ON FROST LINE IN YOUR AREA. THEN ADD APPROXIMATELY 2" OF STONES IN BOTTOM OF HOLE FOR DRAINAGE.
- 3. NOTE: SOME CONCRETES HAVE HIGH ALKALI CONTENT THAT CAN DAMAGE ALUMINUM. TO PREVENT DAMAGE, COAT IN-GROUND PORTION OF POST WITH AN ASPHALT BASE PAINT.
- 4. INSERT POST IN CENTER OF HOLE AND BRACE ON 3 SIDES. POUR CONCRETE INTO HOLE TO LEVEL SHOWN.
- 5. ALLOW CONCRETE TO HARDEN BEFORE REMOVING BRACES.

7" LONG STABILIZING ROD LOCATED AS SHOWN. (IF APPLICABLE)

WHEN INSTALLING POST, MAKE SURE THE END WITH THE YELLOW LABEL WITH BLACK PRINT IS BURIED AS PER ARROWS ON LABEL.

CONCRETE FOOTER TO BELOW LOCAL FROST LEVEL OR LOCAL CODE.

INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS FOR 2 PIECE WRAP-AROUND BASE



- 1. AFTER DIRECT BURIAL POST IS IN PLACE, INSTALL STABILIZER #2 AROUND POST ON TOP OF GROUND.
- 2. POSITION 2 HALVES OF WRAP-AROUND BASE #1 ON BOTH SIDES OF POST. SECURE BASE TOGETHER USING PAN HEAD SCREWS #3. BE SURE STABILIZER #2 IS IN PROPER POSITION TO PREVENT BASE FROM SHIFTING.
- 3. ATTACH BASE ASSEMBLY TO POST USING SET SCREWS #4.

4 PIECES 1/4-20 X 3/8" LONG SET SCREW.
