

Opposites Attract

Please read all instructions before starting. Measurements on borders are approximate, measure your quilt top before cutting

Cutting Directions:

Fabric A- Red Vine

- Cut three 4-1/2" x 42" strips to yield twenty-four 4-1/2" squares.
- Cut one 4-7/8" x 42" strip to yield two 4-7/8" squares.
- Cut seven 2-1/2" x 42" strips for the binding.

Fabric B- Red and Black Dot

- Cut seven 2" x 42" strips. Piece the strips together to make two 2" x 70-1/2" strips and two 2" x 67-1/2" strips for the narrow outer border.
- Cut seven 2" x 42" strips. Piece the strips together to make two 2" x 59-1/2" strips and two 2" x 56-1/2" strips for the narrow inner border.

Fabric C- White with Black Vine

- Cut seven 4-1/2" x 42" strips. Piece the strips together to make two 4-1/2" x 67-1/2" strips and two 4-1/2" x 59-1/2" strips to make the wide border.
- Cut two 4-7/8" x 42" strips to yield twelve 4-7/8" squares.

Fabric D- Black with White Vine

- Cut three 4-7/8" x 42" strips to yield twenty-four 4-7/8" squares.

Fabric E- White with Black Flowers

- Cut three 4-7/8" x 42" strips to yield twenty-four 4-7/8" squares.

Fabric F- Black with White Flowers

- Cut three 4-7/8" x 42" strips to yield twenty-four 4-7/8" squares.

Fabric G- White with Black Squiggles

- Cut three 4-7/8" x 42" strips to yield twenty-four 4-7/8" squares.

Fabric H- Black with White Squiggles

- Cut three 4-7/8" x 42" strips to yield twenty-four 4-7/8" squares.

Fabric I- White with Black Dots

- Cut three 4-7/8" x 42" strips to yield twenty-four 4-7/8" squares

Fabric J- Black with White Dots

- Cut two 4-7/8" x 42" strips to yield fourteen 4-7/8" squares.

Backing- Your Choice

- Cut two 78" x 42" strips. Piece the strips together to make a 78" square piece for the backing.
