INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

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Step 1: Mounting the front door

• The front plate is pre-cut into three pieces: two small pieces that must be mounted on each side and the middle piece that must be able to fold down.

Start by assembling the two small pieces as shown in Figures 1B and 1C. They are mounted with the 2x3 10mm bolts, washers and nuts that are LI left over from the assembly of the rest of the bike.










- Holes are drilled to mount the hinges with a 6 mm drill see picture 1D.
- The front door is mounted with the 6 pcs. M4 16 mm bolts, discs and nuts see picture 1E and 1F.

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Step 2: Install the closing bracket

4 pcs. M4 16 mm bolts
4 pcs. M4 nuts

- Holes are drilled to mount one part of the closing bracket through the wooden plate and the metal in the corner bracket on both sides. Use a 5 mm drill see picture 2A.
- The fittings are mounted with 4 pcs. M4 16 mm bolts and nuts (no discs) see picture 2B.

- Holes are drilled to mount the other part of the closing bracket on both sides. Use a 5 mm drill see picture 2C. Make sure to keep a good distance so that the closing bracket closes tightly.
- The fittings are mounted with 4 pcs. M4 16 mm bolts, discs and nuts see picture 2D and 2E.

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Step 3: Installing the headlight and reflectors

- Drill a hole with a 6 mm drill in the middle of the front plate just above the logo see picture 3A.
- The headlight is mounted with the headlight bracket see picture 3B, 3C and 3D.
