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

PRINTABLE RING SIZE GUIDE

Print this guide onto A4 paper to find out your ring size. Make sure you are printing at 100% and don't use any scaling options, or fit/shrink to page.

OPTION 1: MEASURE AN EXISTING RING

- Select an existing ring that fits your desired finger. For increased accuracy it's preferable to use a ring similar in style to the one you intend to buy.
- Position the ring over the chart below until the inside circumference matches to a specific circle.
- If your ring falls between two sizes, you should opt for the larger size, especially if it has a wider band.
- NB the fingers on your right hand are likely to be different sizes to the fingers on your left hand.



OPTION 2: USE RING SIZER TO MEASURE FINGER

- Cut out the ring sizer and carefully cut the slit (gently fold the slit section in half for easier cutting)
- Push the end of the sizer through the slit to make a loop so the side with the letters is visible.
- Wrap the loop around your finger and adjust the sizer so it sits comfortably
- The letter closest to the slit is your ring size
- Be careful not to pull the sizer tightly – this will give you the wrong size.
