## **General Instructions**

1. This workbook is designed to give children practice in writing and recognizing the letters of the alphabet.


2. Always introduce a new letter before asking the children to complete a worksheet related to that letter. Otherwise, that worksheet will be less than meaningless!

3. Each section includes a page to help children practice writing the letter, plus three visual discrimination pages to help them find and then color the letter. They increase in difficulty from the beginning of each unit to the end. The first two visual discrimination worksheets are very simple, and ask the children to simply identify which letters are the capitals and which are the lower case letters. The final worksheet asks the children to identify which letters are the target letter and which are not.

4. The pages can be used in any order that you like; there is no reason to limit yourself to moving through the pages sequentially from A to Z.






## A is for Alligator

Color each shape that has a capital "A" with a blue crayon. Color each shape that has a lower case "a" with a purple crayon. Color the other shapes any color you choose.




## B is for Bus




Color each shape that has a capital "B" with a yellow crayon. Color each shape that has a lower case "b" with a blue crayon. Color the other shapes any color you choose.
