## Candy Cane Pattern

Place this half on a file folder with the dotted line on the fold. Trace the other half of the candy cane onto the other side of the file folder and cut out. This is your pattern for the large candy cane. Use it to trace two candy canes onto one large piece of $12 \times 18^{\prime \prime}$ construction paper and then cut them apart.
Give each child approximately ten pieces of $1.5^{\prime \prime} \times 3^{\prime \prime}$ white paper. They should glue them down and then trim off the excess paper so that the white matches up to the red paper. I like to tell the children to give the candy cane a "hair cut!"
