

# A CREEPY PAIR OF UNDERWEAR CRAFTIVITY

This is a fun "craftivity" for children based on the book *A Creepy Pair of Underwear* by Aaron Reynolds, with illustrations by Peter Brown.

## Preparation:

Copy the underwear master on lime green construction paper. If your students are still beginners with scissors, you may want to cut it out for them, or even cut part of it out for them! We decided to cut the top and bottom out for them this year and let them do the sides themselves, mostly to help the kids finish the project within the time we had. Each child needs the following pieces of construction paper pre-cut:

Object	Dimensions	Color	Quantity Needed per Child	Special Instructions?
eyebrow	4 x .5	black	1	none
eyes	1.5 x 1.5	white	2	Kids will round off the bottom corners.
bolts (rectangular)	1 x .5	black	2	none
bolts (square)	.5 x .5	black	2	none
mouth	3 x 1.5	black	1	Kids will round off the bottom corners.
teeth	.5 x .5	white	5	Kids will choose the number of teeth they want.

## To Assemble:

Show children how to cut out the underwear, and then round off the bottom corners of the eyes and mouth. Then all they need to do is glue it together as shown, and then add some hair with a black crayon!
