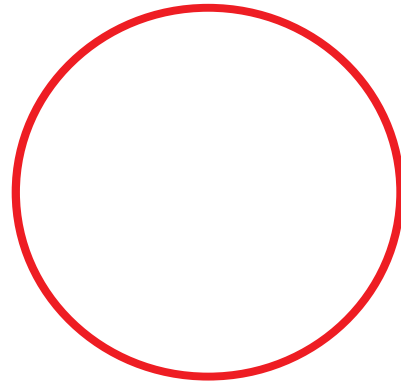


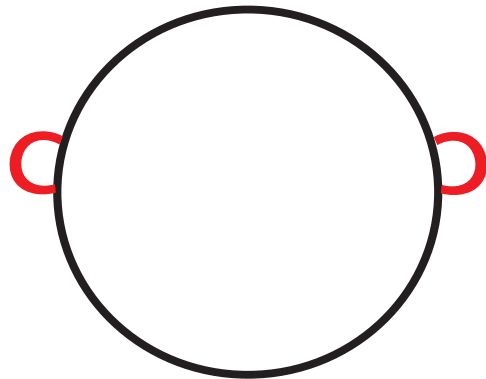
# Dad Guided Drawing Instructions

1. Draw a circle for the head.



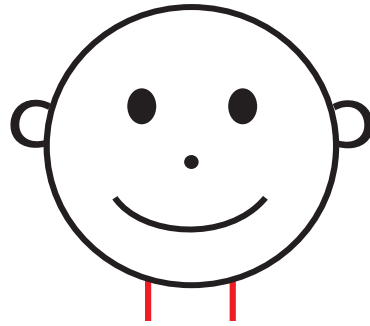
2. Draw a capital C's for the ear on the left side of the head, and a backwards C on the other side of the head.



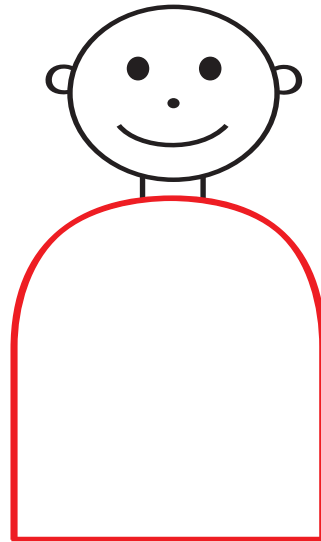
3. Draw one dot for the nose, two dots for the eyes, and a smile for the mouth.



4. Draw a number eleven for the neck.



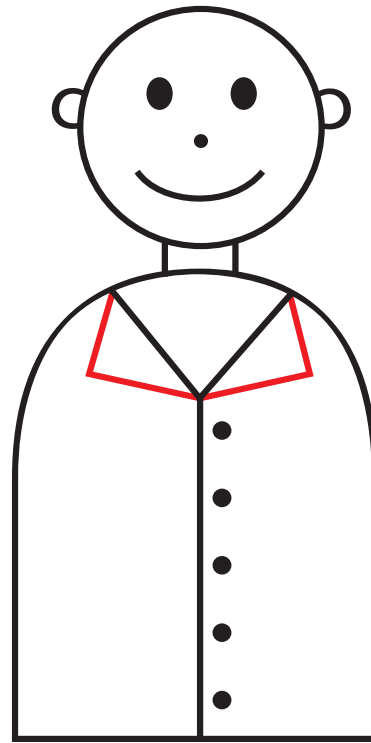
5. Draw a rainbow for the suit jacket. Then put a lid on it on the bottom with a line.



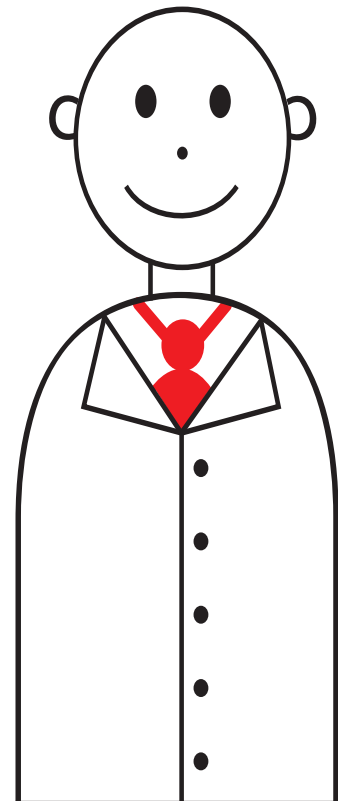
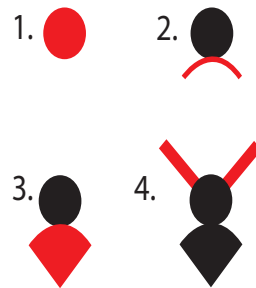
6. Draw a capital Y in the middle of the jacket to make it look more like a jacket. Then add some dots for buttons.



7. Draw two V's for the collar of the jacket.

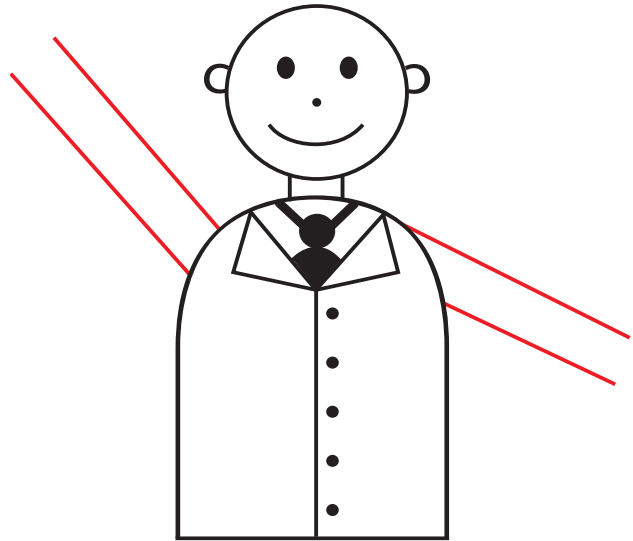


8. For the tie, draw a circle below the neck and fill it in. Then draw a little rainbow below it and fill in the area below it and above the jacket. Then draw two lines above the circle (like a V) to connect it to the neck.

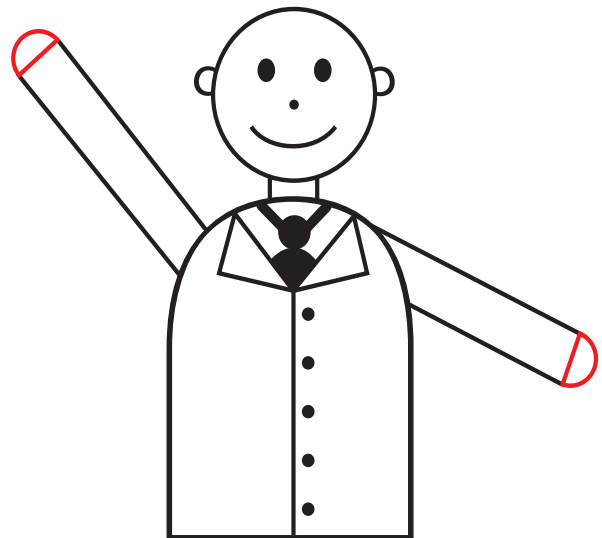


9. For the first arm, tell the children to draw one line going up and another right beside it.

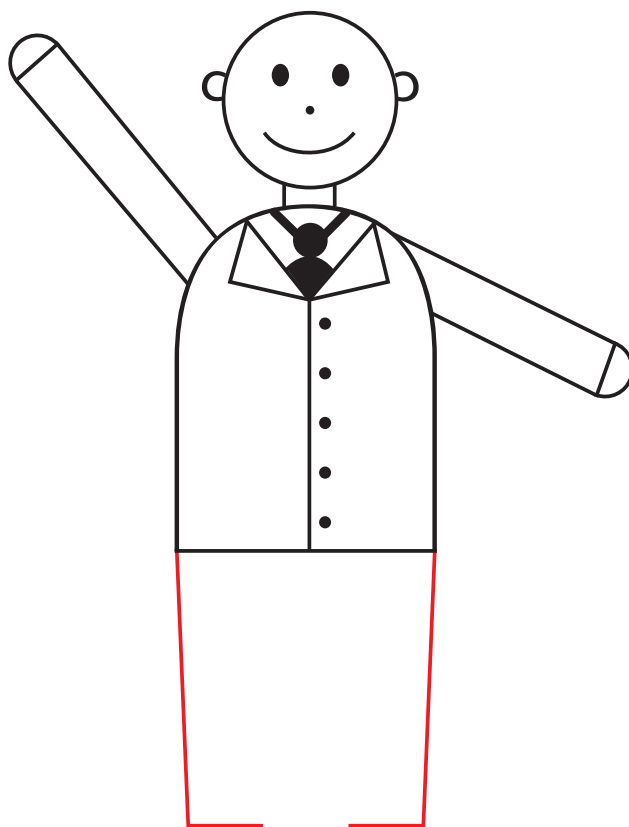
The for the other arm, draw one line going down, and another line right beside it. The arms can really go any direction the kids want, though!



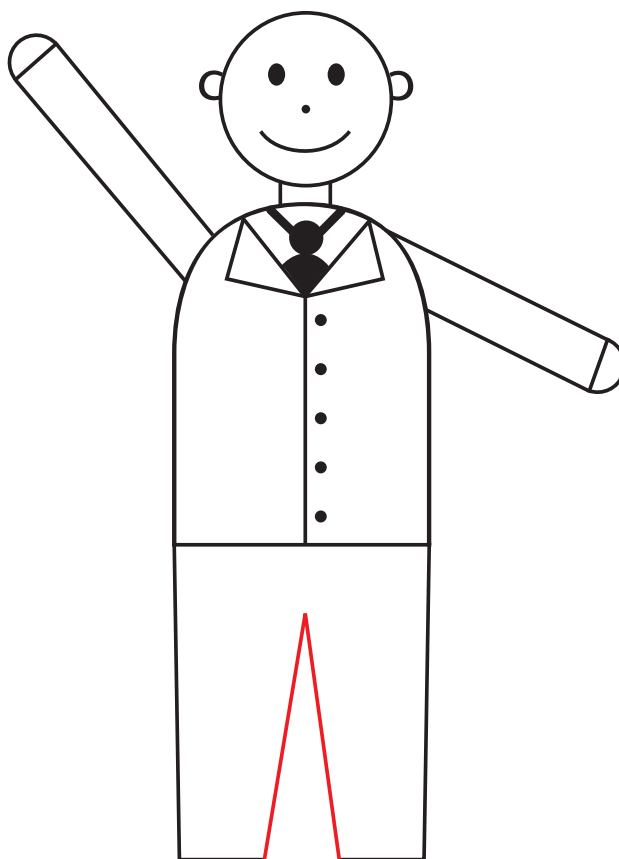
10. For the hands, draw a capital D on the end of each hand. One of them will be going backwards, though!



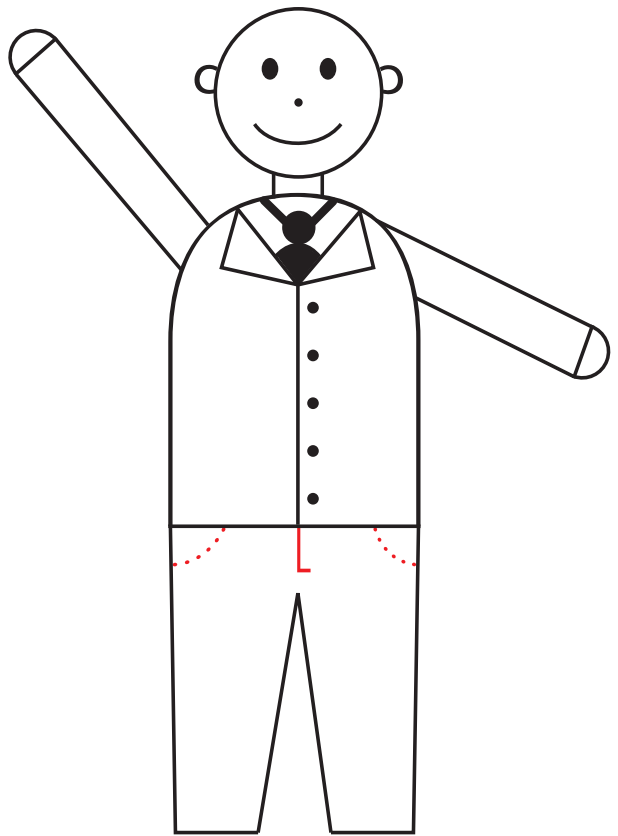
11. Draw a capital L for the left leg, and a backwards L for the right leg.



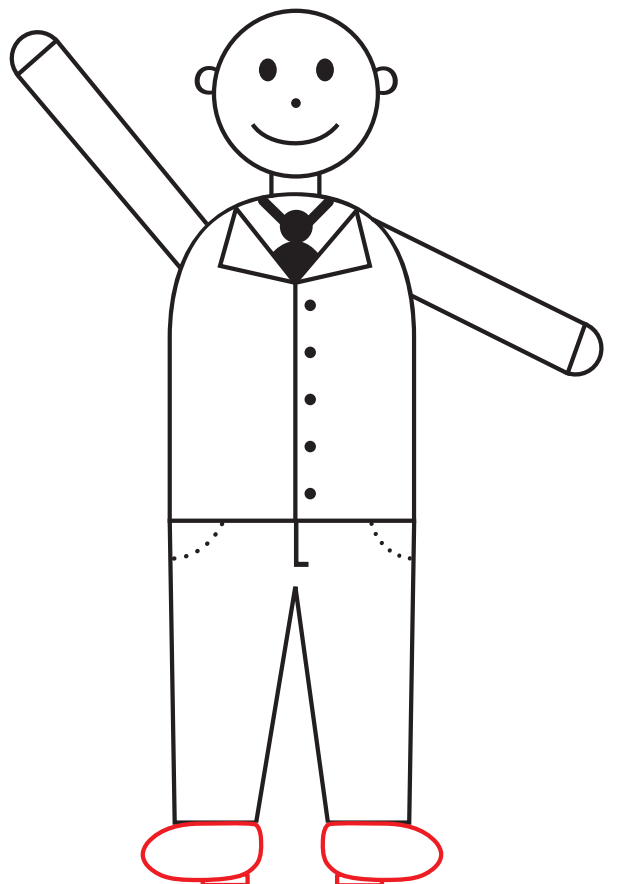
12. Draw a mountain in between the two L's.



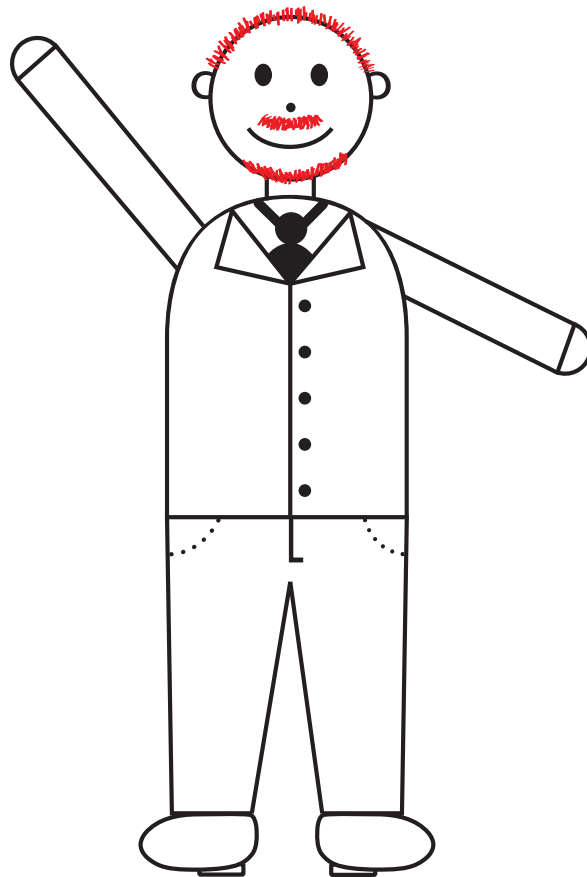
13. Draw a capital L for the zipper, and for the pockets, make two little smiles on the sides of the pants with dots to make it look like stitching.



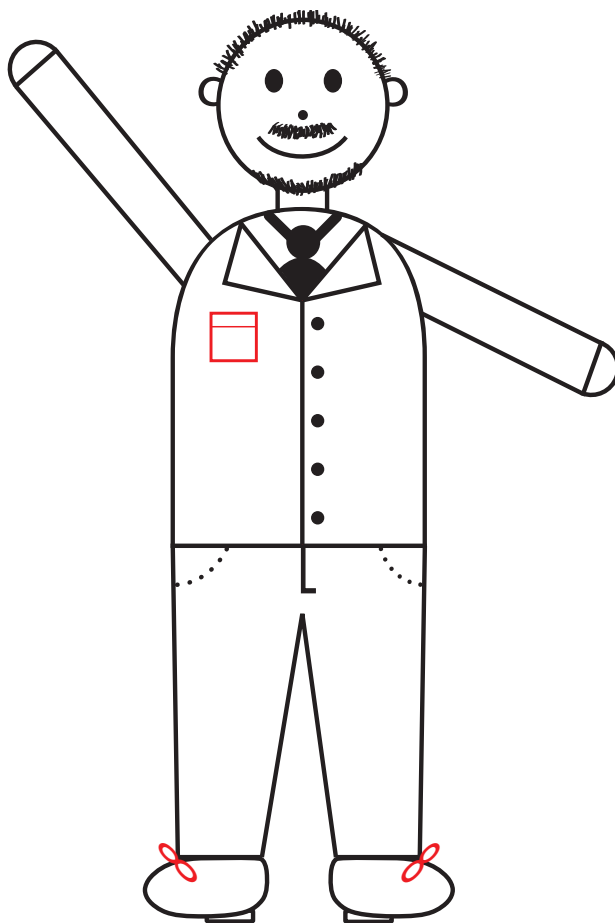
14. Make two hot dogs for the shoes. Then draw half of a rectangle on the bottom of the ovals for the soles of the shoes.



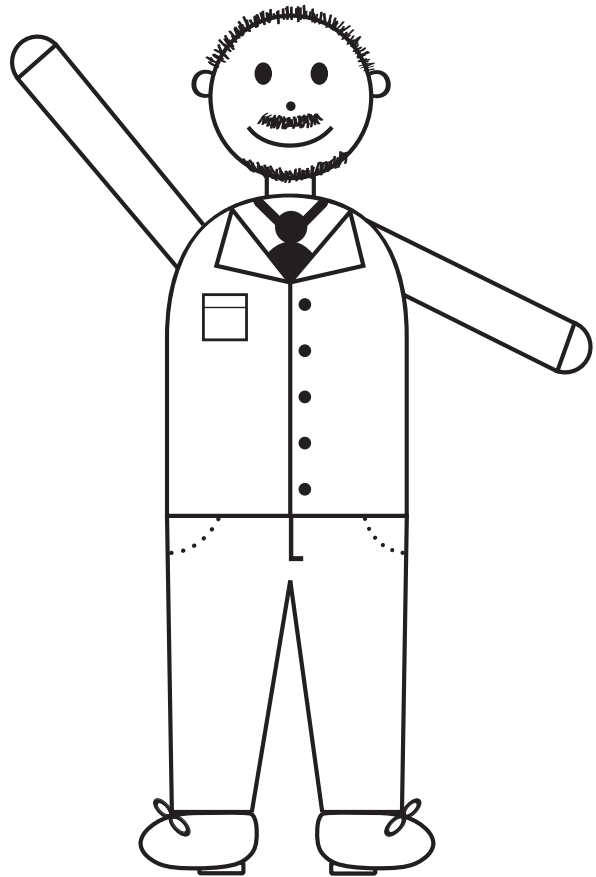
15. Now give the dad some hair. Instruct the children to draw lines on top of the head for hair, and if their dad has a beard or a mustache, they can do the same on the face. Heidi's students made hair to match what they thought their dad's hair looked like.



16. Finish up the dad by adding a square with a line for a pocket on the suit jacket. Then make shoe laces by drawing 8's at the top of the shoes.



17. Your dad drawing is now complete! Now your kids can give their dad drawing some color.



18. You may want to have your students write a letter as well.
