Lincoln's Log Cabin Directions

Note: To make this project, each child will need 9 popsicle sticks. Duplicate the included master for the cabin, and then cut construction paper


into the following sizes:

Gray Background: 12" x 9"

Brown Roof: 4" x 4"


Black Door: 2" x 1"

Black Window: $1'' \times 1''$



Optional: Pre-mount the white duplicating master on the gray construction paper so that it looks like a frame.

To make the cabin, show the children how to lay glue down first and then place the popsicle sticks down on it to make the walls of the house. Then show them how to cut the roof piece into a triangle shape. (If you think they need a tracer or an adult to pretrace it ahead of time, then just cut the rectangle into a triangle to make one.) Then have the children simply glue on the door and the window as shown in the picture. Then tell them to decorate their picture as they wish. Enjoy!
