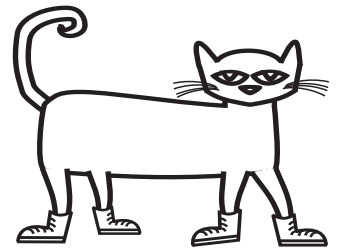


# Pete the Cat Guided Drawing

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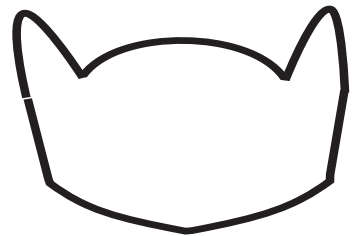


Here are the instructions to teach your students to draw Pete the Cat. Enjoy!

1. Draw a rainbow for the top of his head. Then draw a capital A without the line in the middle for each ear.



2. Draw a number one coming down from each ear for the sides of the face. Then draw a smile for the bottom of Pete's chin.



3. Draw a rainbow for the tops of each of Pete's eyes. Draw a smile under each rainbow for the bottom of the eyes.



4. Make a letter V for the pupils of the eyes. Leave the inside of the pupils white.



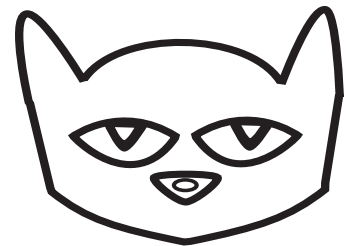
5. Thicken up the lines on the outside of the V's that form the pupils. I tell the kids to color the lines a little bit to make them thicker, but only on the outside- not on the inside.



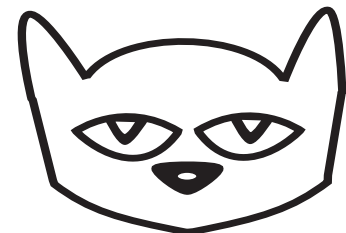
6. For the nose, draw a little circle in the middle of the face and leave it white on the inside. (Some of the Pete books show two nostrils and some show one. Make Pete's nose however you are comfortable drawing it.)



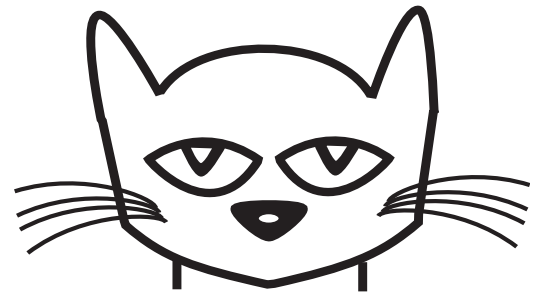
7. Draw a triangle around the circle. (It's important to draw the little circle FIRST and draw the triangle AFTER; otherwise, many children will make the nose so small that a little white circle will not fit inside of it.)



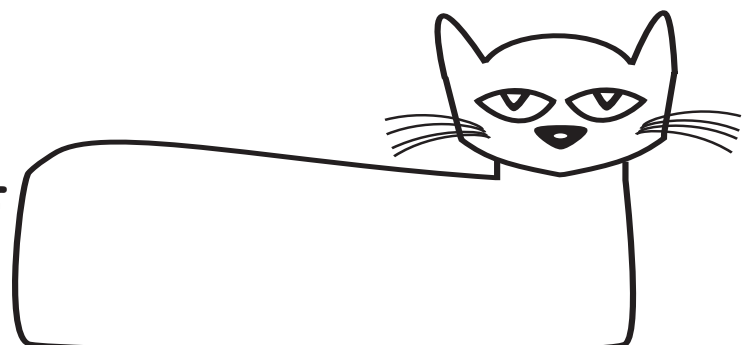
8. Color the nose black, leaving the little circle inside of it white.



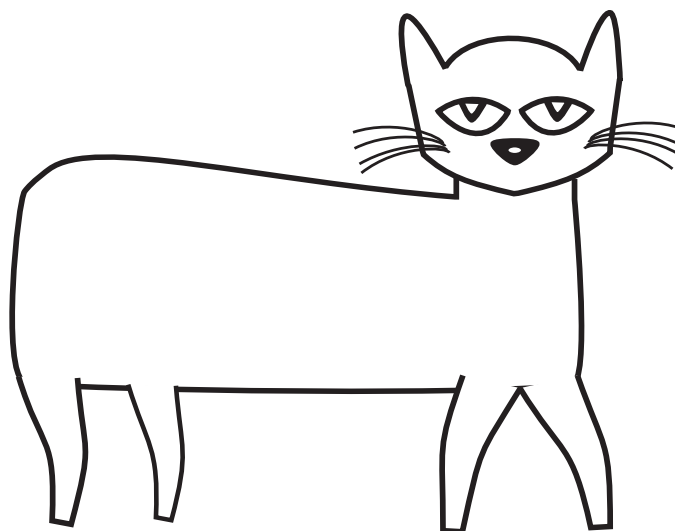
9. Make four rainbows on each side of the face for the whiskers. Make two lines under the chin for the neck.



10. Draw a rectangle for the body, starting at the neck line under the chin as shown.



11. Make two short lines for each leg, leaving room for the shoes. For each leg, I always say, "One line down, two lines down, put a lid on it!" Then I just keep saying that again and again until we have four legs. (You'll probably have at least one child that makes just three legs no matter what, though!)



## 12. Steps for shoes:

*Recommended: Go through all of these steps for each shoe, or many of your younger children will forget how to draw the shoes on the remaining feet!*

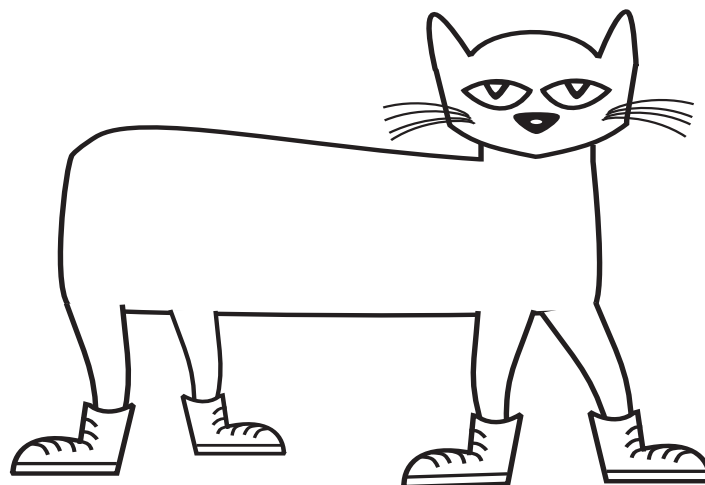
A. Draw an L under the legs.

B. Draw a line coming down halfway on the other side of the shoe, and then add a rainbow to connect it to the bottom.

I told my kids it was like making a lower case h.

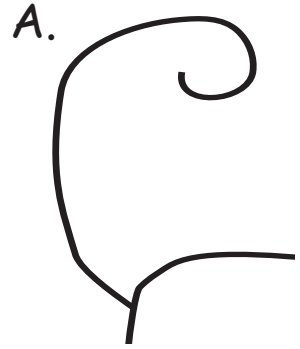
C. Draw a rainbow for the top of the shoe.

D. Draw a line on the bottom of the shoe for the sole. Then draw small rainbows for the shoe laces.



13. Steps for the tail.

A. Make one letter C for the tail, and then put a smile on the end of the tail.



B. Make another letter C very close to the first one, and connect them at the ends.
