## School Bus Art Project

Here are the instructions to make the school bus art project. It is a nice, easy art project for the beginning of the school year and makes a great bulletin board, too!

Each child needs construction paper cut to the following dimensions:

| Item | Quantity <br> Needed | Dimensions | Color |
| :---: | :---: | :---: | :---: |
| bus | 1 | $6^{\prime \prime} \times 9^{\prime \prime}$ | yellow |
| wheels | 2 | $3^{\prime \prime} \times 3^{\prime \prime}$ | black |
| windows | 3 | $2^{\prime \prime} \times 2^{\prime \prime}$ | black |

In the top right hand corner of each bus piece, trace a rectangle the size of the one shown to the right, approximately $21 / 2$ by $13 / 8$ inches. The children will need to cut out a rectangle piece this size before constructing the rest of their bus. The easiest way to do this is to just cut out a piece of cardboard the size indicated and have a helper trace around it for the children ahead of time. However, I have also provided a bus on for you to xerox, just in case you do not have any volunteers and would prefer to just copy it. Copy the bus shape on yellow and then cut around the $6^{\prime \prime} \times 9^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle on the paper cutter. Then they can cut out the window inset themselves. Or, if you think your kids will be alright to do all of
 that cutting themselves, let them cut around the outside of the bus themselves as well.
