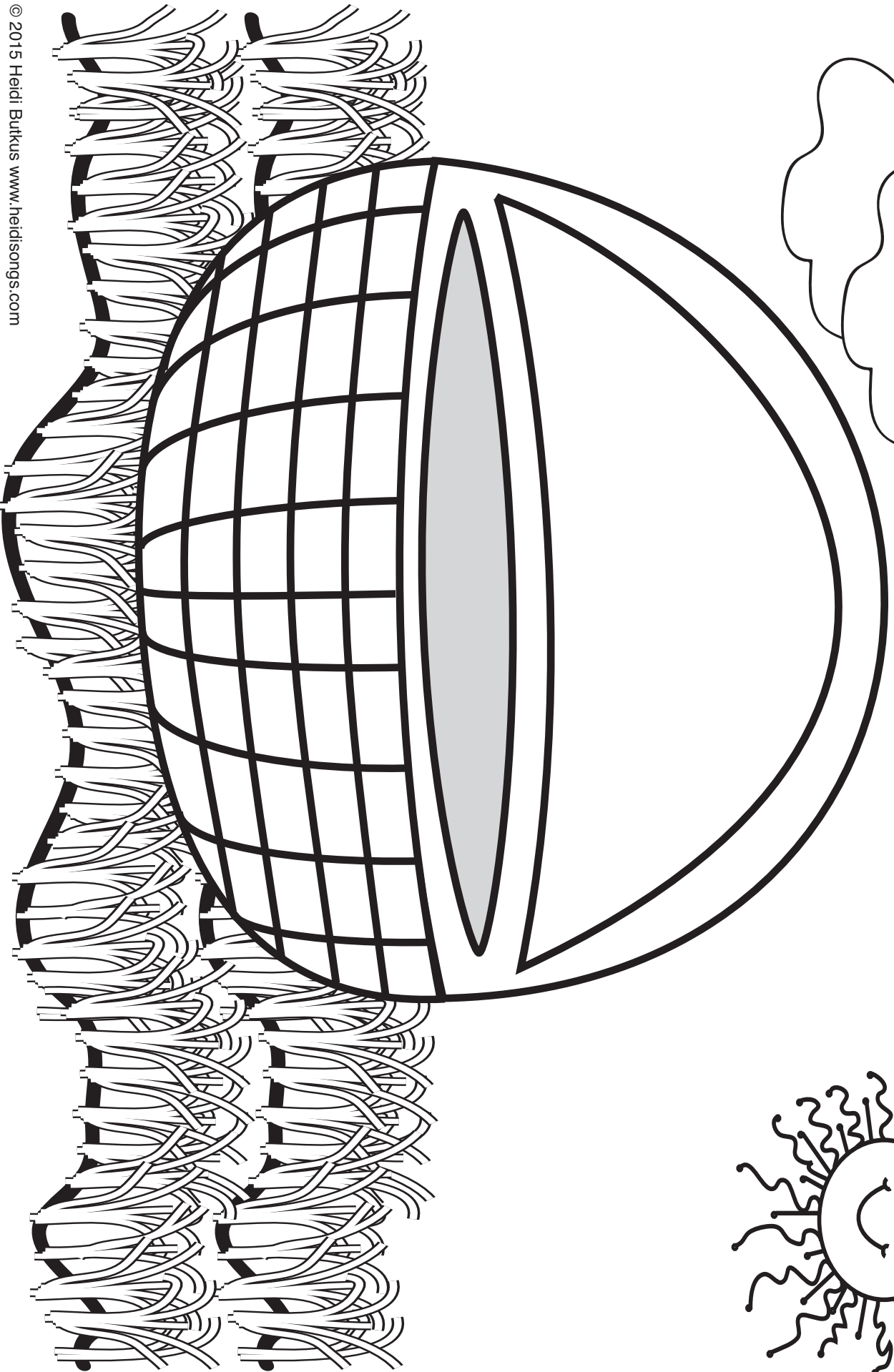
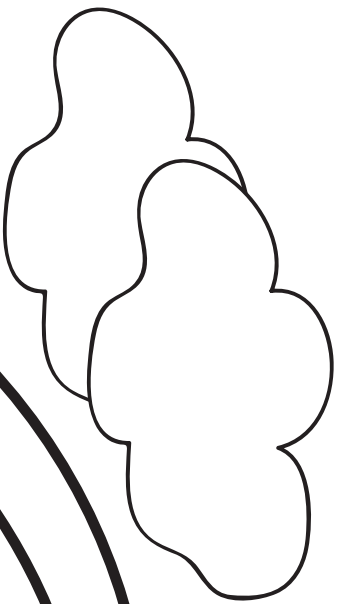
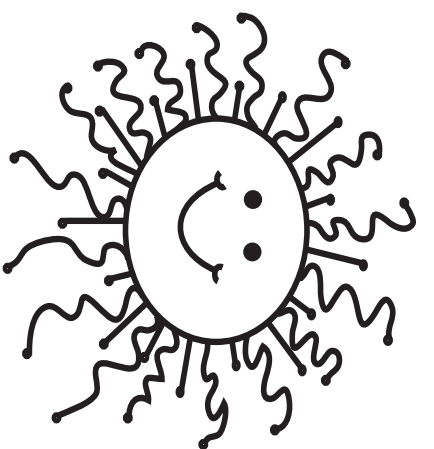
This activity can be done with plastic eggs and a basket or the paper ones provided.

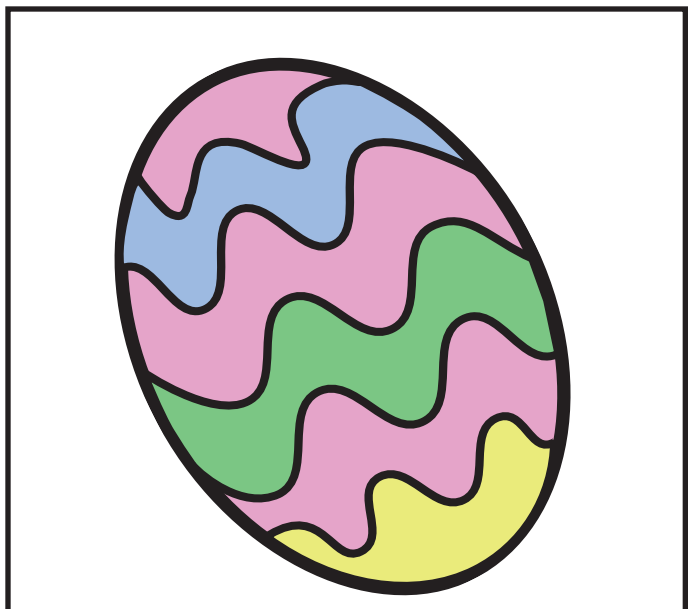
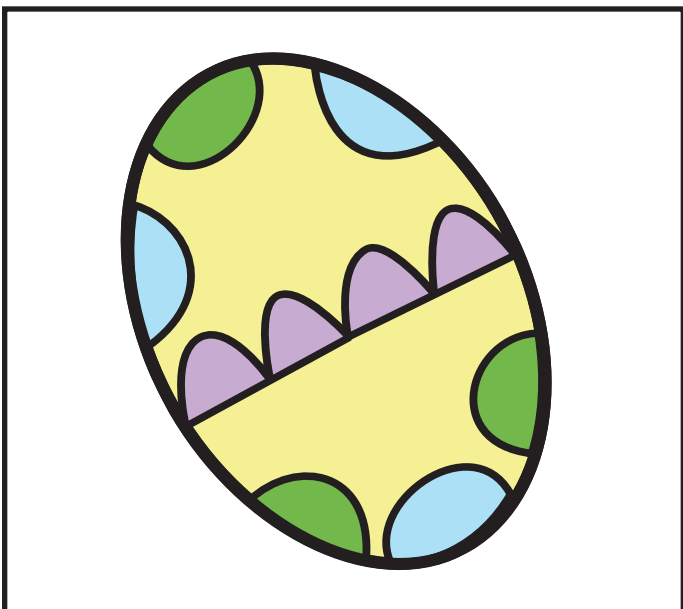
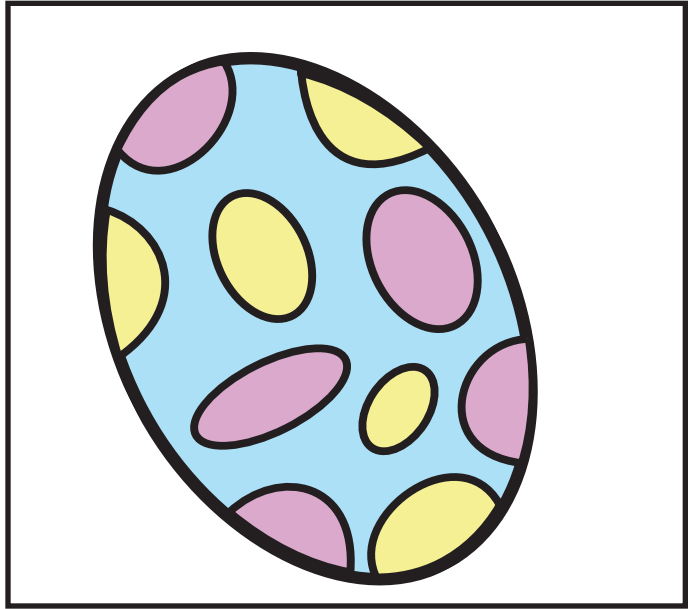
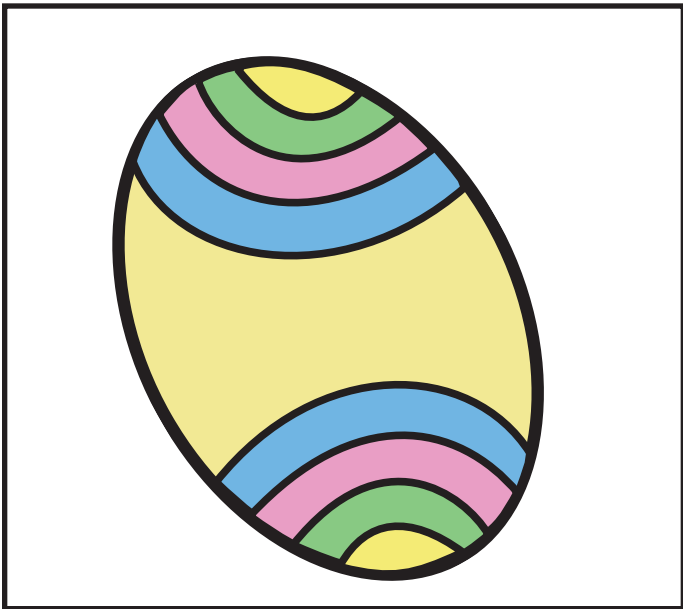
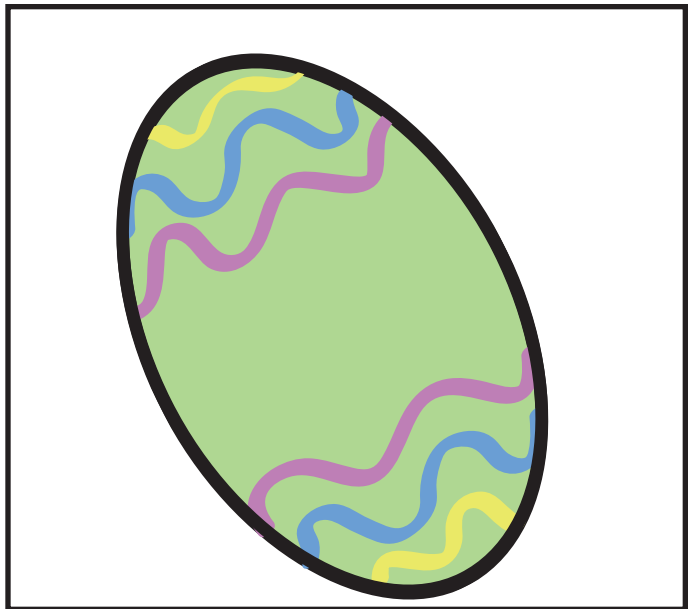
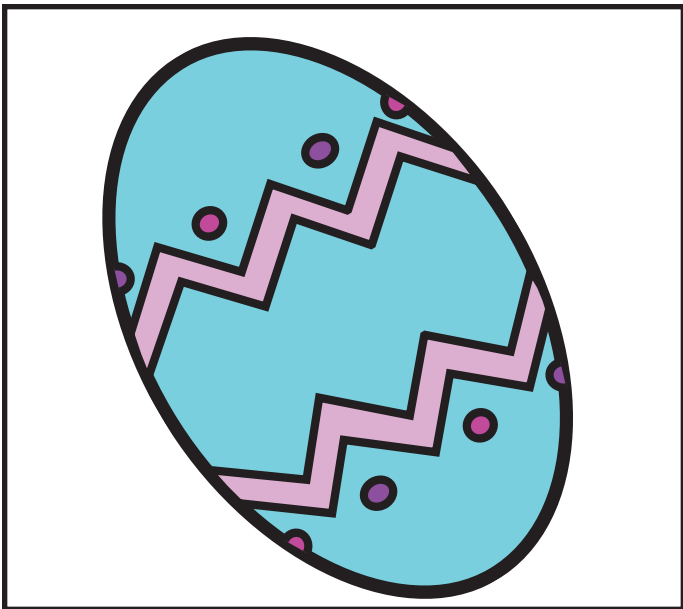
1. Print out one of the activity mats with the grass, sun, and sky either in color or black and white. Or, if you prefer, use a real spring basket! If you are going to use plastic eggs, then there is no need to print out the pages with the large eggs. Then, print the counting worksheets with the small eggs. (One sheet of eggs is colored and one is not. Feel free to use whichever one you prefer, but you will need to print out two pages of eggs total.)
2. Look at the first question on the worksheet. Ask your learner to count out the eggs, and then place that many paper or real eggs into the paper basket. (You may also use a real basket if you prefer.) Then have your child write that number of eggs on the line.
3. Have your child do this for every question on the worksheets.

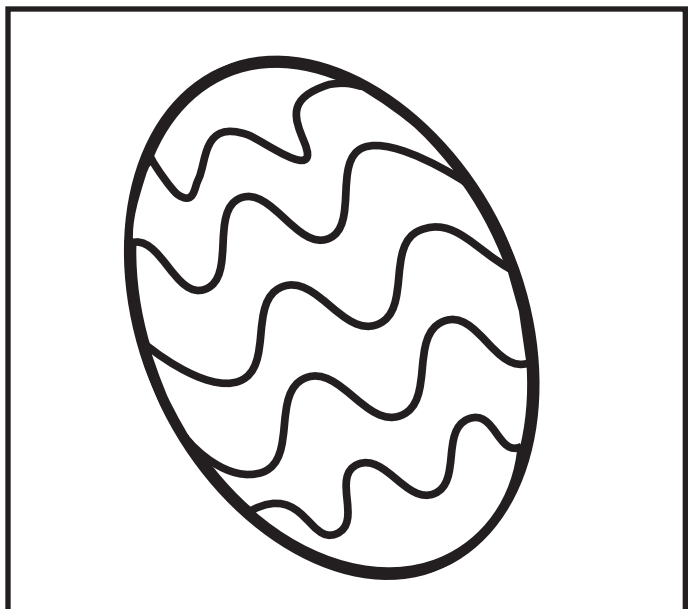
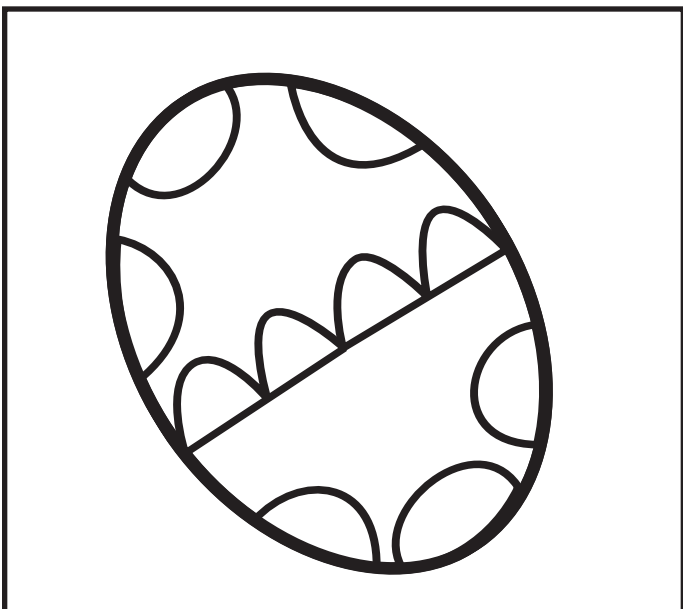
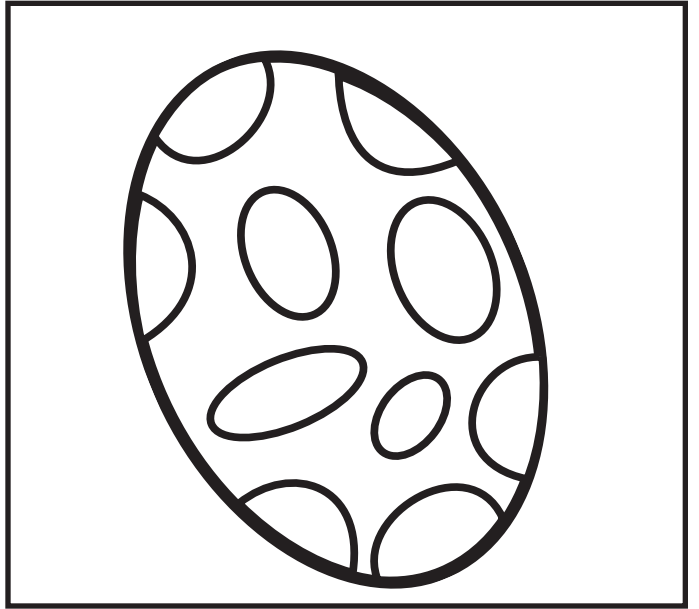
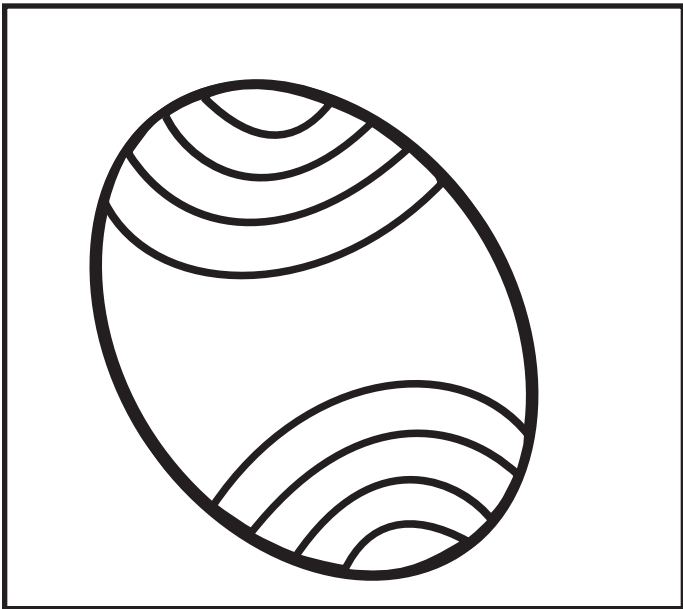
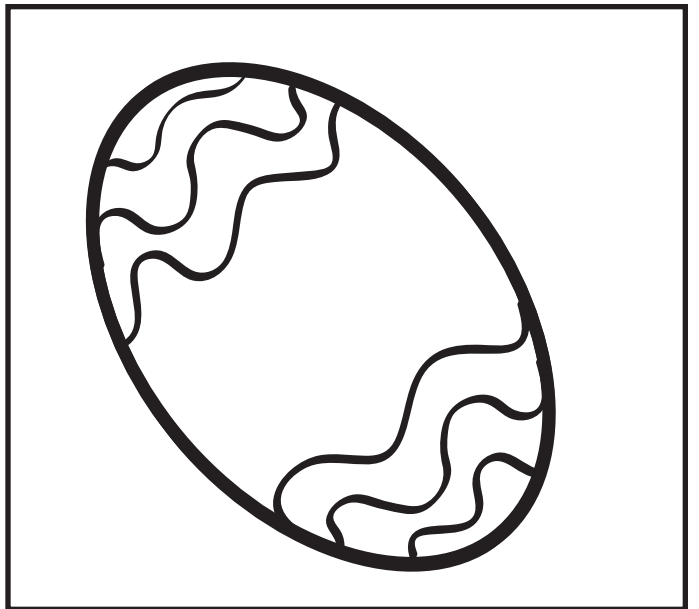
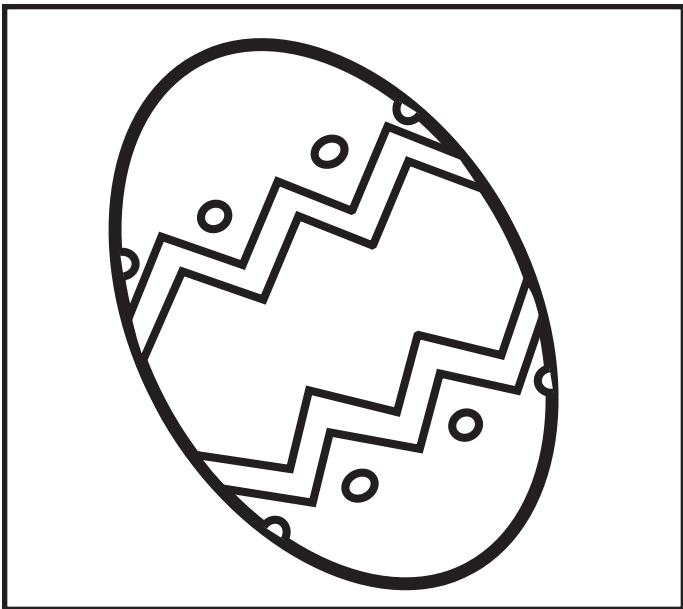
