This season, we also expand our use of Cashmere Silk and versatile, breathable Cotton -creating new silhouettes with natural fabrics we already love. Loungewear maintains its indoor and outdoor status, cementing its position as a wardrobe must-have.

In woven accessories, the Johnstons of Elgin seasonal tartan 'Speyside Summer' makes its debut, in a lightweight Merino Wool scarf, alongside the Johnstons of Elgin House Check. These contemporary tartan designs bring a playful edge to a versatile, transeasonal accessory.

Stripes exude a quiet strength in a tactile new Cashmere scarf this season, and our popular, versatile squares focus on contrast with elegant border details. Similar edge detail carries over to our beautiful Border Cape.
