TASTING NOTES

The fruit for this wine is harvested by hand from the Ehret Family's estate Bavarian Lion Vineyards located in Knights Valley. The Knights Valley AVA is protected from the marine influence of the Pacific Ocean, making it the warmest AVA in Sonoma County. The vineyards on the estate range from 400-800 feet in elevation and are located just north of Calistoga and east of Alexander Valley, on the foothills of Mount St. Helena. The unique topography and soil content make this a most desirable area to grow Bordeaux and Northern Rhône grapes. The soil consists of well drained, very gravelly and sandy loams formed from mixed sedimentary and basic rock.

WINEMAKING NOTES

The 2021 Zinfandel nose offers vanilla, fresh ripe raspberries, and sweet milk chocolage accented with baking spices. On the palate, tree-ripened Bing cherries, candied plum, and boysenberry are followed by toasty oak notes finishing silky, soft, and smooth. Approachable and begging for you to pour another glass for futher enjoyment.
