Yellow Umbrella to Open New Location in Libbie Mill

RICHMOND – Building on the company’s recently announced growth and expansion plans, Yellow Umbrella will be adding another new location in Henrico’s Libbie Mill, with a soft opening planned for March. This news follows Yellow Umbrella’s announcement last year that the company would open a second location and a foray into the Richmond dining scene with a restaurant and raw bar in Scott’s Addition.

The new spot will offer most of the same provisions as the Patterson Avenue flagship location including prepared foods, grab-and-go lunch offerings, baked goods, pantry staples, charcuterie, wine, and beer. There will be hot lunch offerings with house-made soups and made-to-order paninis. Catering will be available for pickup.

While this location will not have an onsite butcher or fishmonger, it will offer a curated selection of the fresh seafood and meat that Yellow Umbrella is known for in a grab-and-go format.

Café and patio seating will also be available.
