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1.0 Introduction

We understand that maintaining independence in the bathroom is a priority, and our lift is designed to make using the toilet safe, comfortable, and dignified. This manual will guide you through the entire setup process, from unpacking the lift to its proper installation and operation. 1.1 Indications for Use

The ArGo Toilet Lift empowers individuals with limited mobility to maintain independence in the bathroom. It tackles the challenges of safely sitting down and standing up when using the toilet, promoting a dignified and comfortable experience. This lift is a perfect solution for those who find traditional methods difficult, allowing them to use the bathroom with greater ease, independence and confidence.



DO NOT use this lift to transport occupants who may have cervical, spinal, or fracture injuries.

1.2 General Description / Intended Use

The ArGo Toilet Lift is designed for both safety and user comfort. Its smooth lifting mechanism allows for effortless transfers on and off the toilet. However, user safety is paramount. To ensure a secure and comfortable experience, always ensure the user is properly positioned in the lift before operating. It's important that anyone using and/or assisting with the lift reads this manual thoroughly to become familiar with proper operation procedures.

This user manual contains general instructions and guidelines for the use, operation, and care of this product. These instructions are not all-inclusive. 2.2 Safety Precautions



- 1. Read this entire manual carefully before using the ArGo Toilet Lift. Ensure you understand all the instructions for safe operation and maintenance.
- 2. Follow the provided installation instructions precisely to ensure the lift is securely mounted on your toilet.
- 3. Never exceed the lift's weight capacity as specified in the manual. Overloading can damage the lift and compromise safety.
- 4. If a user cannot maintain an upright seated position independently, a caregiver or supervisor should be present to assist during transfers.
- 5. Maintain a clean seat before each use. Regularly inspect the lift for missing or damaged parts, and never operate it if something is amiss.
- 6. Always sit down slowly and steadily on the lift to prevent injury and avoid stressing the lift mechanism.
- 7. While the lift is operating, avoid placing hands, feet, or any other objects near moving parts to prevent accidental injury.
- 8. Standing or Kneeling is Prohibited: The lift is designed for seated transfers only. Never stand or kneel on the lift platform.
- 9. The ArGo Toilet Lift is designed for bathroom use. Avoid using it for any other purpose.
- 10. Never leave children unattended while using the ArGo Toilet Lift.

4.0 ArGo Toilet Lift Features







Step 1

Unpack the components from the packaging and ensure all necessary parts are included. Organize them in a clear workspace to avoid confusion during the assembly process.

Step 2

Take the right handle, which has an electrical connector, and carefully align the notches on the plugs. Once connected, twist the threaded collar to secure the connection.



Step 3

Both handles should fit onto the posts located on the base of the lift. Check that the screw holes on the handles align with the corresponding holes on the base for proper attachment.

Step 4

Insert the provided screws through the aligned holes in the handles and the posts. Tighten the screws using an allen wrench to ensure that both handles are firmly secured to the base.



Step 5

Install the adjustable feet into the bottom of the lift by screwing them in. This will allow you to make height adjustments to accommodate the specific toilet height.



Optional Step

If you need the lift to be mobile, you can replace the adjustable feet with the optional wheel set. This allows for easier movement of the lift between bathrooms or different locations.



Step 6

Adjust the lift height by turning the feet to raise or lower the lift to the desired height. Ensure the rear support area of the lift is slightly higher (1/8" to 1/4") than the toilet rim for proper alignment.





6.0 Installation Details

STEP 1

Use a flathead screwdriver and a pair of pliers to remove the bolts and nuts located beneath the toilet that secure the seat. Once the nuts are loosened and removed, lift the toilet seat off the bowl to make space for the new lift installation.



STEP 2

Raise the lift using its control to allow better access. Slide the plastic cover off the rear support and install the brackets by guiding the bolts into the slots, using an allen wrench for assistance if needed.





STEP 3

After the brackets are aligned and installed, tighten the bolts securely to ensure the lift is stable. Once everything is securely in place, slide the rear support cover back over the crossbar to complete the installation.





7.0 Charging the ArGo Toilet Lift

Your battery should arrive with some charge. However, it is recommended to **fully charge it** before first use. Make sure to plug the power adapter directly into a power outlet. When the power is connected, the indicator light on the adapter will turn on.



Charging Methods

- Method 1: Remove and Charge
 - a. Raise the lift halfway.
 - b. Pull up on the silver handle to remove the battery from the lift.
 - c. Plug the battery into the charger/ power supply.
- · Method 2: Charge in Place
 - a. If the battery is low and cannot raise the lift enough to remove it, plug the charger/power supply into the rear of the lift.

Ensure your ArGo Toilet Lift is

plugged into a GFCI-protected

outlet. Avoid mixing water and

electricity to ensure safe operation.



Failing to recharge when the battery reaches a low status will cause battery failure, **requiring a battery replacement.**

Charging Your Argo Toilet Lift

To keep your Argo Toilet Lift in top shape, follow these simple charging steps:

- 1. Charge Only Until Full: Plug in the unit until the battery indicator light shows it's fully charged. Once the light indicates a full charge, unplug the unit to prevent overcharging.
- 2. Avoid Full Discharge: Be mindful not to let the battery go completely dead, as this can lead to the need for a replacement battery.

By following these steps, you'll help extend the life of your battery and keep your unit ready to use!



8.0 Operation Details



1.

Stand in front of the lift and use the buttons on the right handle to lower the seat. Once the lift reaches a comfortable height, sit down slowly as the seat continues to lower you into position.





While seated, complete your usual routine comfortably. The lift remains stationary while in use, providing a stable platform for support.

After using the toilet, press the button on the right handle to raise the lift. As the seat lifts you, place your feet firmly on the ground and use the handles for balance until you are in a fully standing position.

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10.0 Care and Cleaning Instructions

Regularly clean the ArGo Toilet Lift to prevent dirt and debris buildup. Use a mild detergent and water to clean the surfaces of the lift. To clean the surfaces of the ArGo Toilet Lift, create a mild detergent solution, wipe down all surfaces with a damp cloth or sponge, and dry thoroughly.

Do not scratch or scrape the surface of the product with hard objects to prevent material damage.

Do not use products that have bleach or phenolic cleaners. Check the height adjustment of the lift to ensure it is still set at the desired level. If necessary, adjust the feet of the lift to maintain the proper height.

Inspect the handles periodically to ensure they are securely attached. If any screws are loose, tighten them using the provided allen wrench.

Inspect the toilet brackets and bolts to ensure they are securely attached to the lift and the toilet. If any bolts are loose, tighten them using the allen wrench.

In a medical setting, we recommend you disinfect the lift between riders with basic disinfectant for patient and operator safety.

If any issues or defects are noticed, contact Climbing Steps, Inc. for warranty service and repairs.

11.0 FAQs

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Is the ArGo Toilet Lift compatible with different types of toilets?

The ArGo Toilet Lift is suitable for a variety of toilet types, as long as the toilet is less than 21" wide and the rim is between 14" and 18" tall. This makes it versatile and adaptable to different bathroom setups.



How portable is the ArGo Toilet Lift?

For ease of us, the Argo includes four optional wheels that allow users to use the lift in multiple locations, providing convenience and flexibility. This adaptability is particularly advantageous for medical facilities seeking versatile equipment for patient care.



Can the ArGo Toilet Lift be adjusted to accommodate different toilet heights?

Yes, unlike some other toilet lifts and lift assist devices, the ArGo Toilet Lift is adjustable to accommodate different heights. It has adjustable feet that can increase or decrease the height between 14" and 18", allowing for customization based on the toilet bowl height.



Are there any specific clearance or space requirements for using the ArGo Toilet Lift?

Yes, the ArGo Toilet Lift requires the toilet to be less than 21" wide and have a rim height between 14" and 18" for proper operation. It is important to ensure the toilet meets these requirements to ensure compatibility with the lift.



12.0 Troubleshooting

If you have any questions about the bridge bath lift, please call us for customer service assistance. The device label will also show the serial number and the date manufactured.

Problem	Cause	Solution
The ArGo Toilet Lift is not lifting or lowering.	The device is not properly plugged in or the battery is not charged.	Ensure the power cord is securely plugged into a working electrical outlet or check that the battery is fully charged. If using the battery, switch to the plug-in option to test if the battery needs replacement.
The lift moves slowly or stops during operation.	The lift is overloaded beyond its weight capacity or there is an obstruction.	Check to ensure the user's weight does not exceed the lift's capacity and remove any obstructions from under or around the lift.
The lift makes unusual noises during operation.	Components may be loose.	Inspect the lift for any loose parts and tighten as necessary.
The lift seat is not adjusting to the desired height	The adjustment mechanism is jammed or malfunctioning.	Check for any debris or foreign objects obstructing the mechanism. Clean and inspect the adjustment controls.
