

Stainless Exhaust Maintenance

Stainless Steel does require maintenance. The best way to maintain your exhaust is to remove road grime and oils periodically.

Depending on your location, if the dirt/rocks on the road contain iron in them, they can deposit onto the exhaust and cause tarnishing.

You can remove these blemishes/discoloration by using Scotch Brite pads and Metal Polish.

ALWAYS GO *WITH* THE GRAIN OF THE METAL. NEVER SWIRL.

Green Scotch Brite for the brushed look.

Grey Scotch Brite to shine that up.

Metal Polish and Micro Fiber to make it show polished.

Make sure to always check all bolts to ensure the exhaust is still tight.

Doing this will ensure your Stainless Exhaust stays looking like new for years and years to come!
