Summary: still red wine made from indigenous grapes. 750ml, 13% ABV

Grape: 100% Baladi Aswad (black), an indigenous Palestinian varietal characterized by elliptic black berries

Farming: Dry farmed, harvested by hand in September.

Region: Cremisan Valley, Bethlehem, Palestine (800m)

Soil: Limestone

Yield: 15hL/Ha

Production: 15,000 bottles

Winemaking: Grapes are handpicked at the beginning of September and de-stemmed into stainless tanks. The grapes are fermented with skins and seeds using selected yeasts. The wine is aged in oak barrels for 14 months before being filtered twice and bottled.
