

- You can receive a warm massage by using the heating function.
- Enjoy a massage while listening to music via Bluetooth.
- The anti-jamming safety sensor allows you to use the massage chair safely.

About the Power

The product voltage is AC 120V (for South Korea).

It cannot be used with a transformer. Please use a grounded 120V outlet for the power plug.
There is a risk of fire due to overheating

If the power cord or plug is damaged or if the outlet is loose, stop using the product and contact our customer service



When using an extension cord, please use a grounded outlet.

· Using an ungrounded outlet may result in electric shock or injury.



Do not place heavy things on top of the power cord, and avoid having





- Those who need absolutely quiet surroundings.
- Those who have back pain.
 Those with weakened muscles due to old age.

Infants, children, and pets

Infants, children, and pets should be kept under the supervision and guidance of a guardian so that they do not play or climb on t op of the massage chair.



Do not let infants, children, or pets get under the massage chair, in the rear part, or in the leg control area.



· Otherwise, accidents or injuries may occur.

Please only use the reclining mode after confirming that there are no people, pets, or objects in the rear part or the front or bottom of the leg area.

When lowering the legs, please confirm that there are no people, pets, or objects underneath before operating.





Do not use the massage chair while wet or without clothing, or when you're carrying sharp or hard objects, such as accessories on your head.

Check the position of the massage ball before using it, and sit down slowly.



 There may be a risk of an accident or injury occurring while using it.

This product has a heating function. Those who are insensitive to temperature changes, those with reduced mobility, infants, and children should all exercise caution. Furthermore, there is a risk of burns when using the heating function for long periods of time.



While the product is in use, never put your head, hands, or feet between the chair legs, under the chair, or in the leg area.



· This may result in injury or product failure.

If the product is not working or has problems, remove the power plug and contact the customer service center.

About the Power

After using the product, turn off the power switch and remove unused power plugs from the outlet.

In the event of a power outage, immediately turn off the power switch and remove the plug from the outlet.

Do not knock over the massage chair or hit it.

Do not use or drag the wheels on surfaces that are easily scratched, such as hardwood floors or rugs.

Do not move the product while people or objects are on it



· There is a risk of product failure, damage to the bottom part, or injury.

Since the floor may become damaged, placing a rug, etc., under the product is recommended.

In the event that the leg rest and back rest are adjusted, leave space in the front and rear in advance.



· When adjusting the leg length, do not adjust the leg length with great force.

Using the Massage Chair

If any of the side effects listed below occur while using the product, stop use immediately.



· Abrasions, contusions, bruises, wounds (punctures), or cuts caused by the product.

· Damage to muscles, tendons, nerves, and the spine due to excessive use and pressure.

· Skin diseases, burns, etc.

Fractures, dislocations, sprains, etc.

· Respiratory and digestive disorders, suffocation, etc.

The maximum usage time per use is 30 minutes. Do not exceed the daily maximum usage time of 60 minutes.



This can cause safety accidents or injury.

This massage chair is meant for 1 person to use. It should not be used by 2 or more people at the same time.



There is a risk of product failure or injury.

The recommended user weight for this product is 265lb or under. Please keep this in mind when using it.



· This can lead to safety accidents, injury, or malfunction.

This appliance is not intended



- Exercise caution to prevent children from playing with the product.

 This may lead to electric shock or injury.

The recommended safe use period of this massage chair is 5 years.

If the recommended safe use period is exceeded, there may be a risk of fire or electric shock due to the aging of parts.

The free customer service period is limited for commercial use and public facilities.

This product is not intended for medical use in hospitals.

Do not use it right after eating.

While operating the product, do not use other treatment devices at the same time.

· Malfunctions may occur.



Do not use after consuming alcohol.

Do not remove the plug or turn off the power switch while the product is operating.

· There is a risk of injury and product failure.

Do not climb on the back, shoulders, arm rests, or legs of the massage chair.



Do not wipe or spray with benzene, alcohol, or thinner.



• There is a risk of injury and product failure.

When not using the product for a long time, be sure to unplug the power cord. If the product has not been used for a long time, check that it is operating normally before use.



• It may result in an electric shock, fire, or discoloration.

When operating in the reclining mode, be careful not to get your head, hands, limbs, etc., caught between the back rest, seat, and arm rests.



· It may cause an electric shock or fire.

· There is a risk of injury.

After installing the product, be sure to check that it operates normally, and use it properly after familiarizing yourself with the details of the instruction manual. Store the product warranty separately.

(Customer service may be paid for the storage of the product warranty.)

- When you are done using the massage chair, press again for 2 seconds or longer to turn it off.





- Restart the desired function.


Product Structure and Part Names



How to Install and Move the Massage Chair

How to Install the Massage Chair

- Check the space where you plan to install the massage chair.
- Make sure the installation area is level.
- When adjusting the back rest and legs, consider securing an extra space of 33 cm or more for the legs and 10 cm for the back rest.



- Place mats on the floor to prevent damage to the floor.
- Avoid installing it near places where it can be easily exposed to direct sunlight, as well as heating appliances.

How to Move the Massage Chair

- Press the back rest to open the front part (the leg area).
- With the front part (leg area) in the air, move it by pushing it on the floor using the wheels. Never move the product while it's in contact with the floor. The floor will be damaged.



- When moving the product, do so with 2 or more people.
- The product is heavy, so please move it carefully. * During transportation, do not apply force to the leg unit or foot unit.






How to Use the Massage Chair

How to Use the Massage Chair

- Check the surroundings of the product.
 - Make sure that there are no people, pets, or objects around the massage chair, such as the front (leg part) and back (back rest part) of the product.



- Check the product.
 - Check that there are no damaged parts on the surface of the massage chair other than the head pad. If any damage is found, do not use the product and proceed with customer service after turning off the power plug.



3 Check if the plug and remote control are damaged or if there are any unwanted debris.






4 If no issues are found, insert the plug into the outlet and turn on the power switch on the product's body.





5 Before sitting down, check that the massage ball is in its default position on the backrest. Then, sit with your head and back pressed against the massage chair.




6 Press the red power button on the remote control for more than 2 seconds, read the message, and press OK. Select the function you want using the remote control.


If you press the remote control's power button for more than 2 seconds, a message will appear.


Before operating the massage chair, please check if there are infants, children, pets, or other obstacles around the massage chair.



Shoulder recognition and body shape analysis are possible

- When entering the Automatic/Manual/Air mode, the shoulder recognition function is activated. Once the shoulder position is detected, press the OK button. If the shoulder position is not correct, adjust the position by pressing the arrows.
- 2 After shoulder recognition is completed, the body shape analysis function will be activated. The body shape analysis feature is a function that analyzes your body shape, from the buttocks to the back, a total of 8 times.
 - ※ If your body shape cannot be analyzed, an error message will be shown. Sit with good posture and press the OK button to start the body shape analysis again.
 - ※ If the body shape analysis does not start for about 20 minutes, the power is automatically turned off.



Operation of the anti-jamming safety assistance system

Safety device	Details
① Leg unit length adjustment safety sensor	In the process of shortening the space between the foot and the calf, if an obstacle is detected, a warning message will be displayed and the foot part will be extended to the maximum length.
② Leg unit bottom safety sensor	If an obstacle is detected while the leg unit is coming down, a warning message will be displayed and the leg unit will move up as much as possible.
③ Safety detection switch on the back of the leg unit	If an obstacle is detected while the leg unit is coming down, a warning message will be displayed and the leg unit will move up as much as possible.
Safety detection switch at the back bottom part of the product	If an obstacle is detected while the product is reclining, a warning message will be displayed and the product will move up as much as possible.

▶ Steps to take when the anti-jamming safety assistance system is activated

- 1 Check around the massage chair and safety sensor. If there are infants, children, pets, or other obstacles, move or remove them promptly.
- After confirming that there is nothing around the massage chair, press the OK button on the obstacle detection indicator displayed on the remote control.
- Restart the desired function.

- If you press the power button for more than 2 seconds, a notification will appear.
 Check the message and tap OK to display the Standby mode screen.
- 2. If you press the Automatic Mode button on the remote control, you can see the 12 automatic modes on the display window of the remote control.
 - (Please refer to the table for the description of functions of the Automatic mode.)
- 3. You can select a desired mode using the direction buttons and the OK button to start using it.
- 4. Change the time to 10, 20, or 30 minutes by pressing the Time button.
- 5. While a mode is in operation, you can switch to another mode or a different massage mode by touching the desired mode for activation. (Please refer to the instructions for each mode.)
- $\label{power-up} \ \ \text{Mode entry, the system detects shoulder position and performs body shape analysis.}$
- * During the body shape analysis, please do not press other buttons.
- * If the shoulder position is incorrect, it can be adjusted up and down when detecting the shoulder.
