Conas atá tú?	Kun-ass a-taw to?	How are you?
Tá me go maith	Taw may guh maw	I am well
Go raibh maith agat	Guh rev mah ah-gut	Thanks
Tá fáilte romhat	Taw fall-che row-at	You're welcome (response to thanks and a greeting)
