Who is Pax Domini Press?

Pax Domini Press is a small but growing publishing company which aims to provide an alternative to the highly commercialized products of the leading Christian publishing houses.

What are some Pax Domini Press Products?

Pax Domini Press has published nine Vacation Bible School programs, each available for purchase at \$150. These programs include: Lord, Have Mercy (on Law and Gospel), In the Name (on the Holy Trinity), I Am (on the 7 I Am's in the Gospel of John), According to the Scriptures (on Christ in the Old Testament), Take up the Cross (on the baptismal life), The Remission of Sins (on Holy Absolution), Fervent Love for One Another (on Christian charity), Five Words of Understanding (on the ICHTHUS), and A New Song (on the songs of Scripture).

Finally, *Pax Domini Press* has available three Sunday School curricula. Like the VBS program, this curriculum is produced for self-publication. One curriculum is entitled, *Teaching them to observe all things*, which takes the student through the entire Gospel of Matthew. Another curriculum is entitled, *A.D. The Acceptable Year of the Lord*. It follows the Gospels of the Historic Lectionary. Finally, a new curriculum, *The New Song*, teaches Scriptural backgrounds for the texts of the liturgy.

What is included in this sample packet?

Included in this sample packet are a picture of the front cover, brief explanations of the materials given in the kit, lessons from each level (from Level 4 down through Level 1), a sample from the puppet show, and a sample from the daily prayer bulletin, including the hymn.

How does Pax Domini Press's Vacation Bible School program work?

Pax Domini Press produces a CD with all the files needed for a congregation to publish a VBS program. Included on the CD are the following:

- 1. PDF files of a Program Manual with guidance on program implementation, instructions for the craft, and ideas for recreation time.
- 2. PDF files of teachers editions of each student workbook.
- 3. PDF files of workbook pages for the student workbooks.
- 4. PDF file of chapel bulletin with prayer service for each day of the program.
- 5. PDF file of puppet show script for use with Level 1 material.
- 6. PDF files of advertising materials (door hangings, bulletins, bulletin headers)
- 7. Extra electronic images and PDF files to be used with Level 1 material (coloring pages, activity pages, etc.) or for the craft (patterns, verses, etc.).

With these resources, the congregation simply assembles the workbooks, bulletins, and craft materials. The cost of the VBS can cost anywhere from \$10/child to \$20/child (pending on whether the craft kit is purchased on not, also pending on how the workbooks are assembled).

How do the workbooks work?

The congregation receives a CD with color and black/white PDF files of workbooks for Levels 1-4. The congregation has permission to do whatever it wants with these files. They may do the following:

- (1) Simply print them off for the children
- (2) Take them to a printing professional to make booklets for the children
- (3) Advanced copiers/printers may have capabilities to produce booklets from PDF files

What is the theme of I Am?

The Gospel of John is famous for Jesus' several "I Am" statements. Seven times He says "I Am...the Good Shepherd, the Way (etc.), the Light, the Bread of Life, the True Vine, and the Resurrection (and the life)." Through the use of these "I Am" statements, Jesus clearly reveals Himself to be the Lord God, the One Who appeared to Moses at the burning bush saying, "I am who I am."

Through these seven "I Am"s, Jesus reveals His Person and work. This Vacation Bible School is anchored in these seven "I Am"s. Using the simple images of the "I Am"s, this VBS teaches basic doctrines of the faith such as the Ministry, Law and Gospel, Baptism, Holy Communion, and the Resurrection.

Here is a summary of the lessons for the five days:

What is the craft like?

Typical *Pax Domini Press* crafts meet a high standard of materials, meaning, and craftsmanship, requiring strong oversight by craft supervisors. The goal is a craft that engages the child artistically as well as theologically. The craft for *I Am* fits these qualifications.

The craft for "I Am" is a set of seven ornaments, underscoring the notion that the "I Am"'s are all about the Person of Jesus, Whose Incarnation we celebrate on Christmas. Craft instructions are

given for each ornament, and with certain "I Am" statements, two sets of directions are given. Craft materials may be easily attained at a craft store. Pax Domini Press does not have craft kits for this program. Some of the crafts require use of a scroll saw.

A picture of the seven ornaments is given here.

What about worship?

Pax Domini Press provides a worship folder which has a simplified Matins service for each day of the week. In the service are the Matins versicle, a Psalm, a hymn, a reading, a message, the Lord's Prayer, and the Apostle's Creed. The hymn uses original words – five verses summarizing the five lessons of the week – and puts them to the tune of several hymns which may be found in the hymnal. A sample of a day of the prayer service and the words of the hymn are given at the end of this packet.



What about the pre-schoolers?

The Level 1 material includes a puppet show (which older children may also enjoy) and a story booklet written in simple language. Also included is a teacher's book with suggestions and ideas for songs, games, and activities which will emphasize the theme for the day.


Congregations interested in expanding their program to include 3 year olds may also purchase *Let the Little Children Come unto Me.* This is a "catechism kit" with coloring books and a mini-VBS that teaches the Holy Trinity. See website for more details.

What else does the kit come with?

The kit also comes with recreation ideas. These recreation ideas are activities which incorporate the theme of the VBS. The kit also includes masters for canvassing, posters, and bulletin inserts. Finally, the kit gives some guidance and advice on running a VBS; it includes a check-list of things which must be done 3-4 months prior, 3-4 weeks prior, 3-4 days prior, during the VBS, and after the VBS.

Level 4 Sample

I am the Way, the Truth, and the Life. I am the Door.



In the last lesson, we learned that Jesus is the Good Shepherd who takes care of the sheep. We learned that we have original sin which causes us to wander away from the Lord and commit actual sin. We also learned that Jesus seeks us out and saves us.

Today we learn the way by which Jesus leads us back into His sheepfold. Imagine a large field where sheep graze, eat, and drink. Imagine a large fence around the entire field. The fence keeps the sheep in, but it also keeps wolves out. Now imagine Jesus standing at the door deciding who will be allowed in and who will not be allowed in.

In other words, if a sheep is brought into the protection of the flock, it will only be through Jesus. This is the meaning of "I am the Way, the Truth, and the Life." It is also the meaning of "I am the Door."

Jesus is the only Way to heaven! Jesus is the only Door to heaven! In fact, Jesus says that no one can get to the Father but through Him.

Read the following about how Jesus is the Door from John 10: 1-10:

Jesus the Door


[Jesus says,] "Most assuredly, I say to you, he who does not enter the sheepfold by the door, but climbs up some other way, the same is a thief and a

robber. But he who enters by the door is the shepherd of the sheep. To him the doorkeeper opens, and the sheep hear his voice; and he calls his own sheep by name and leads them out. And when he brings out his own sheep, he goes before them; and the sheep follow him, for they know his voice. Yet they will by no means follow a stranger, but will flee from him, for they do not know the voice of strangers."

Jesus used this illustration, but they did not understand the things which He spoke to them. Then Jesus said to them again, "Most assuredly, I say to you, I am the door of the sheep. All who ever came before Me are thieves and robbers, but the sheep did not hear them. I am the door. If anyone enters by Me, he will be saved, and will go in and out and find pasture. The thief does not come except to steal, and to kill, and to destroy. I have come that they may have life, and that they may have it more abundantly."

Jesus the Way

Only Jesus is the Way which leads us to the heavenly Father and to heaven. Jesus is the only Way because Jesus is the only Person Who died for the sins of the world. Remember, this is what makes Jesus the "good" shepherd. Jesus alone has laid down His life for His sheep.

Jesus the Shepherd took on our sins and died in our place. He suffered and died for original sin and for all the actual sins that we have ever done!

The Door into Jesus' Flock

How then does Jesus stamp His cross upon us so that we might become part of His flock? Read the following passage:

Acts 4: 10-12

By the name of Jesus Christ of Nazareth, whom you crucified, whom God raised from the dead, by Him this man stands here before you whole....Nor is there salvation in any other, for there is no other name under heaven given among men by which we must be saved.

Yes, it is "by the name" of Jesus – and in the name of Jesus alone! – that we are saved.

Holy Baptism

Sometimes when you go to a club, or a concert, or a festival, you will get a stamp on your hand when you go in. That stamp means that you have paid for entrance. If you leave, you can come back. The doorkeeper will see the stamp and let you back in.

Baptism is the same thing. Jesus Christ has paid our way into heaven with His own blood. And He stamps us with His name so that we are allowed into heaven.

In the beginning of each Divine Service, the pastor says "In the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit."

By doing this, the pastor acts as the "doorkeeper" who calls us to remember that we have the stamp which allows us into the presence of the Lord. A good way to remind yourself of this stamp is to cross yourself when you hear the pastor say these words.

Introduction

In the first lesson, we learned that Jesus is the Good Shepherd. He laid down His life for the sheep to protect them from the wolf. That is, He died for all our sins.

In the second lesson, we learned that lesus is the only Way to heaven. He is the only Door which opens up into heaven. We also learned that the Way or Door into heaven is Holy Baptism. Baptism forgives all our sins.

Today we learn how Jesus lights the way to heaven. Let us imagine being a sheep who has wandered away into the forest far away from the flock. Jesus the Good Shepherd has found us, and He is going to lead us back to the flock.

Let us imagine it is the middle of the night and that it is very dark in the forest. If lesus is going to lead us, He will need to give us light.

lesus is the Light of the World. He leads the way to heaven by this Light.

Jesus the Light

Listen to this passage which speaks of Jesus being the Light of the World:

Jesus said, "I am the light of the world. He who follows Me shall not walk in darkness, but have the light of life."

Based on the following passages, how do the following passages explain the picture above?

Psalm 119: 1-5 – Your word is a lamp to my feet And a light to my path.

The Darkness

Jesus is the Light of the world because the world is a very dark place. Jesus says, "the light has come into the world, and men loved darkness rather than light, because their deeds were evil. For everyone practicing evil hates the light and does not come to the light, lest his deeds should be exposed."

People love darkness because it hides their sins. Most crime happens at night! But when Jesus talks of darkness, He means all sin that happens anytime, even during the day.

Law and Gospel

Jesus is a light in our dark world of sin, crime, death, and hatred. How is Jesus a light in this world? He shows us the sin of the world, and He shows us that He is a Savior of the world.



LAW The Law shows us our sins. GOSPEL The Gospel shows us our Savior.

The Law shows us that we are sinners. We may believe that we do not need a Savior, but then God's Law shows us that we break all God's laws. For example, God's Law says, "Thou shalt not kill." We might not think that we have ever killed someone, but Jesus says that if we are angry with our brother, we break this commandment.

When we learn that we are sinners, Jesus also shows us the Light of the Gospel. What is the

Gospel? The Gospel is the good news that Jesus died on the cross for all our sins. When we feel sorry in the darkness of our sins, the Good News shines in us and comforts us. All our sins were paid for by Jesus at the cross.

The Law shows us that we are sinners. The Gospel shows us that Jesus died for all our sins.

Introduction

Today we learn two new "I Am"'s. "I am the True Vine" and "I am the Bread of Life." Vines produce grapes. Grapes make wine. What happens with bread and wine in church?

[Jesus says,] "I am the true vine, and My Father is the vinedresser. The Father cuts off any branch that does not produce fruit. He also prunes branches so that they might produce more fruit. A branch cannot produce fruit unless it is in the vine. I am the vine, you are the branches. He who lives in Me produces much fruit because I am in him. You cannot do anything without Me. If anyone is not in Me, He will be a branch that withers and dies."


What does it feel like to be close to someone you love? Jesus is so close to us that He is in us, and we are in Him.

I Am the Resurrection and the Life





Jesus said, "Your brother will rise again."


Martha said, "I know he will rise again in the resurrection of the dead."

N: Sorry, ma'am, that's not the password. That was more of a pass-sentence. I need a passWORD, please, ma'am. You have one more chance.

J: OK, OK...let me think... passWORD...just one word. Oh, duh! I got it! How could I have missed this one! I should have known who I'm dealing with: Nickolai, the most self-absorbed dog on the block! What other word could possibly be the password but...NICKOLAI.

N: How did you guess?!! How did you know that that was the password? You cheated!

J: Get outta my way, I said the password. Now you have to be true to your word and let me by!

N: Awww, that's no fun!

J: Well, Nickolai, come inside with me. What just happened reminds me of something that I want to talk to you about.

N: [Sighs] OK.

[The dogs walk off the stage and then pop back up on the stage, now inside their home.]

J: What just happened reminds me of something that Jesus says. Actually, it reminds me of two things Jesus says.

N: What, "Get out of my blasted way!"?

J: No, Jesus never said that. But Jesus says, "I am the Way, the Truth, and the Life, no one gets to the Father but through Me." And He also says, "I am the Door. If anyone enters by me, he will be saved."

N: Ah, I see. So you're saying that I was like Jesus?

J: Don't get a big head. Jesus isn't as infuriating as you.

N: What, then, does Jesus need a password before we can get into heaven?

J: Not really a password. But it's sort of like how I couldn't get into the house without knowing your name. Jesus teaches us that the only way we can get into heaven is by His Name.

N: So we just have to say the magic word, "Jesus" and we'll get into heaven?

J: There's a little more to it than that. Jesus is the only Name by which we get into heaven because Jesus is the only Person Who has made it possible for us to go to heaven. No other names will get you into heaven.

N: No other names will get us into heaven? What about "Bob"?

J: Nope. Bob didn't do the things Jesus did to get you into heaven.

N: What about "Buddha" or "Allah." Will those names get us into heaven?

J: You mean those false gods of the Buddhists and the Muslims? Nope, Nickolai. Those false gods did not die on the cross for you or rise from the dead. Only Jesus did that. Jesus is the ONLY Name by which anyone can go to heaven.

N: Oh, I see...and that's how Jesus is the Door. Jesus is the Door which opens up into heaven.

J: Yup! So, Nickolai. Do you know where Jesus gives His Name out to all the children here? Do you know where Jesus marks His Name on them so that they can pray to Him and call upon Him?

N: I know. But let's see if the children know. Do any of you know where Jesus puts His Name upon you that gets you to heaven?

[When the children answer "Baptism," the skit concludes...]

N: That's right! In Holy Baptism, Jesus gives us the "secret password" so that we can get into heaven. Jessie...do you want to play "spy" again now?

J: After all that excitement, Nickolai, I think I need a nap!
