Membership Conditions & Policies 100 Club Sponsorship Conditions & Policies

1a. Membership Conditions

- α. All the facilities which comprise Parkwood Golf Course (also referred to as "the Club") are privately owned. No member of the Club has, by their membership or the payment of membership dues, fees or other charges, any ownership, equity or proprietary interest in the Club and the Club property and facilities except for those members who have an ownership or proprietary interest in the Owner.
- b. Members are entitled to a non-exclusive and revocable license and privilege to use and enjoy the Club property and facilities and participate in any activity and program organised by the Club in accordance with the rights and privileges attached to the member's Membership Category and the Membership Conditions and Policies.
- c. The Owner or Club Management (as the agent of the Owner) may terminate or revoke membership privileges at any time and for any reason.
- d. The Owner may appoint from time to time, persons or a company to manage and operate the Club and Club property and facilities. No member has, by their mem bership or the payment of membership dues, fees or other charges any right to vote or to have involvement in the management and operation of the Club.
- e. The Owner or Management may establish and adjust fee structures and make rules for management of its facilities. This includes, but is not limited to adjustment of booking times, hours of operation and the closure of facilities for tournaments, weather conditions, maintenance or other reasons.
- f. There is no distinction of membership rights by virtue of gender.
- g. The maximum term of membership is 12 months and no guarantee is made for continuance of membership for further periods.

1b. Sponsorship Conditions

- h. The standard golf membership available at Parkwood Golf Course and the 100 Club sponsorships hold equal booking rights.
- *i.* A registered 100 Club Sponsor must have implied authority as a minimum or actual authority, to enter in a contract for the purposes of being a 100 Club Sponsor.
- j. The successful registration of the 100 Club Sponsorship is non-refundable.

2. Application for Membership

- a. Applications for membership must be made on the Membership Application Form, which must be completed in all respects and signed by the applicant.
- b. Applicants rejected for membership have no recourse against the Owner or Club Management.
- c. No member has, by reason of their membership only, any liability for any of the debts, obligations or liabilities of the Club or the Owner.
- d. Each member and if a corporate member, each guarantor, has personal liability for the payment of all Club accounts, membership dues, fees and other charges imposed on the member by Club Management.

- e. Club membership is by application and acceptance only, and the annual renewal of membership is at the option and discretion of Club Management.
- f. Membership will not be renewed unless the membership dues, fees, charges and Club account for the previous membership year is fully paid.
- g. A member may resign membership in the Club by delivering to Club Management 30 day's prior written notice of resignation. Notwithstanding any resignation, termination or suspension of membership, the member is liable for any amount unpaid on the member's Club account, and for unpaid membership dues, fees and other charges.

Sponsorship Application Conditions

h. If a direct debit scheme is available for the 100 Club Sponsorship, an upfront payment will be required at the discretion of Parkwood Golf Course.

3. Suspension and Termination of Membership

A membership may be suspended or terminated by Club Management if, in the sole judgment of the Club Management, the member:

- a. Fails to pay any amount owing to Club Management in a prompt and timely manner, or fails to pay appropriate fee prior to tee off (green fee – if applicable; shared cart hire).
- b. Submits false information on the Membership Application Form.
- c. Permits the membership card or club account to be used by anyone other than the designated holder.
- d. Deliberate abuse of own or hired golf equipment, deliberate damage to trees or fixtures on golf course, abuse to wildlife, verbal or physical abuse to fellow members, competitors or staff members.
- e. Removal of golf balls from water hazards other than your own or purchasing golf balls from unauthorized persons on golf course.
- f. Bringing the golf course or golf club into disrepute.
- g. Blatant disregard of the rules of golf.
- h. Offensive behavior or conduct.
- *i.* Engages in or refrains from any other conduct or obligation determined by Club Management as appropriate for suspension or termination of membership as determined by Club Management from time to time.
- *j.* No member is entitled because of such restrictions or suspension to any refund of membership dues, fees or other charges.

4. Leave of Absence

- a. Members are entitled to a maximum of 12 months leave of absence at any one time. The request for leave of absence must be in writing and submitted to Club management.
- b. There will also be a fee of \$199 to be paid before the commencement of leave.
- c. Leave can only be taken on the date of your membership expiring.



d. After one year's leave of absence, members are required to pay one year's member ship before another leave of absence can be taken.

5. Sick Leave

- a. Members are entitled to a minimum of 12 weeks sick leave at a time on the provision of a medical certificate, supplied at the onset of illness.
- b. A maximum of 6 months can be taken on one medical certificate. After 6 months if further leave is required, another medical certificate must be supplied.
- c. If sick leave is taken part way through a membership year, a credit will carry over to the following year. This will be a "time" credit equivalent to the sick leave time used, up to a maximum of 12 months.
- d. No refunds will be given.

6. Members Mailing Address

Each member is responsible for maintaining a mailing address with Club Management to which the member wants all Club notices, Club account statements and any invoices, other Club publications or correspondence to be sent. A member is deemed to have received mailings from the Club five days after they have been mailed to the address on file with Club Management.

7. Loss or Destruction of Property or Personal Injury

- α. Each member, as a condition of membership, and each guest, as a condition of invitation to the Club property and facilities, assumes sole responsibility for his or her property.
- b. The Club is not responsible for any loss or damage to any private property used or stored on Club property or facilities.
- c. Members, family members and guests of members must not remove any property which belongs to the Club from the area in which it is located or from Club property and facilities, unless authorised by Club Management.

8. Members Advisory Committee

- a. Management may from time to time invite or appoint a Members Advisory Committee.
- b. The function of the Advisory Committee is to:
 - i. Implement competitions and Honour Board fixtures and structure
 - ii. Run Pennants teams
 - *iii.* Arrange and run members annual presentation dinner and members social functions.
- c. The Members Advisory Committee does not have the right to be involved in the management and operation of The Club at Parkwood Village, other than the functions detailed in the previous paragraph.
- d. Club Management may reject any member to the election on the Members Advisory Committee without cause.
- e. Management may also disband this Committee without having to justify its reasons at any time.

Dress Standards

- a. There should be no need for the Club to exercise supervision over the dress of Members.
- b. Members should use their own discretion to dress in a neat, tidy and appropriate fashion and ensure that their guests are also dressed appropriately.
- c. The following is NOT considered suitable dress: shirt worn outside shorts (unless de signed for this purpose), shirts without collars, thongs, beach, board or abbreviated shorts.

9. Booking Etiquette

- α. Bookings are essential to not only ensure a tee time, but also to avoid any embarrassment to a Member or Staff.
- b. Booking can be made online or direct in the Pro Shop. Online booking through your members' online login should be a member's first point of call, but our Pro Shop staffs are always available to assist you with a booking.
- c. Competition timesheets are made available 8 days prior to the competition date.

 Management reserves the right to release time sheets at its discretion.
- d. Members in the Student and Junior category will be able to book competition times 5 days prior to the competition date.
- e. Cancellation of a tee time can be done via the internet or Pro Shop. You are required to cancel your booking if you are not able to make your tee time. This will also allow for the provision of tee times for other players.
- f. All players should report to the Pro Shop 15 minutes prior to tee time.
- g. All Members must present their Membership Card to Pro Shop staff when checking in.
- h. Groups are limited to a maximum of four players with the lowest handicapper to "captain" the group unless nominated before play.
- *i.* The group "captain" will be responsible for etiquette and observance of the R & A Rules of golf for that group.
- *j.* Each player must use their own set of golf clubs or hire a set of golf clubs from the Pro Shop.
- *k.* Lowest handicapper will also ensure the players in that group carry sand buckets, re pair divots through the green, repair pitch marks on the green and surrounds and rake bunkers.
- I. All players should be aware of the local rules and temporary local rules before play.
- m. Players are required to go to the tee to stand by for tee off after reporting to Pro Shop
- n. The "captain" of each group will ensure that the group keeps its position in the field and is encouraged to play in such a way as to avoid slow play.



10. Work Health and Safety Act

Please remember that to enable the course to be kept in optimum condition, the Course Maintenance Staff have right of way. Do not hit up on them at any time. You could be held liable for any injury caused to them. Please do not hit up on any competitor as injury to them as a result is your liability and could prove to be expensive for you!

11. Membership Cards

A membership card showing your name, membership number, type of membership and expiry date will be issued shortly after joining The Club at Parkwood Village. Please ensure that you keep this card safe, as it must be shown to Pro Shop staff prior to your round and also to obtain member's discounts and benefits throughout the Club. Members must not allow their membership card to be used by any other person and members must notify management immediately if their card is lost. Cost will be \$10 for a replacement card.

12. Electric Golf Carts

- a. Cart fees are charged on a per cart basis at a discounted rate for members.
- b. ALL cart hire must be paid for prior to going on course failure to pay appropriate fee may result in suspension.
- c. Carts must be shared when a 2-ball or 4-ball is playing. Members are not permitted to use 1 cart each.
- d. Carts should remain on paths around tees and greens. Where a cart path does not exist, carts should be parked no less than 10 mtrs from tees and greens.
- e. Carts must be returned to the Cart Bays by 5.00pm in the winter months and 6.15pm in the summer months.
- f. Any damage to carts must be paid for. Note All members are covered by SportsCover and must notify the golf shop of any injury, damage or loss of property, or damage to adjoining residential property due to ball strike.
- g. Any deliberate damage caused to carts may result in suspension.
- h. Repeated breaches of cart etiquette may result in suspension.

13. Handicaps

- a. Handicaps will be maintained by Parkwood Golf Course for all members who nominate it as their "Home Club" for the purpose of the Handicapping Rules of Golf Australia.
- b. Handicaps will be maintained by Management in accordance with those rules.
- c. Handicaps of members shall be available from the Members computer located in the pro shop / clubhouse and online.
- d. Parkwood Golf Course shall not be liable, in any way, to members in respect of any errors or omissions made in the keeping of handicaps.

14. Food and Beverage / Alcohol

- a. All food and beverage consumed on club facilities must be provided by the Club.
- b. Alcohol may only be served during hours permitted by law and in accordance with the Club's Liquor Licence and the Liquor Act.
- c. All alcoholic beverages consumed or carried on the Club facilities must be purchased from the Club.
- d. Food and beverage tabs offered to customers in relation to the 100 Club Sponsorship promotion are limited to successful registrations only. The food and beverage account awarded to customers will increase to reflect the new amount if the member completes the registration form for The 100 Club and the new member of the 100 Club Sponsorship is successfully registered.

15. Children

Children under the age of 18 years are permitted in the clubhouse only if accompanied and supervised by an adult member.

16. Animals

With the exception of guide dogs for the visually impaired, no dogs or other pets are permitted on the Club facilities without the prior approval of Management.

17. Suggestions and Complaints
