WHAT IS DETERMINATION?

These same people found ways to purposefully manage their time and surrounded themselves with other determined individuals. Their outcome was positive because they chose to stay focused and push themselves to overcome the adversity.


BE INTENTIONAL: Map out your starting and ending points by writing down the steps that you need to do to stay on track. If you know someone who's had success, ask them to share advice on creating a plan.

MAKE IT A HABIT: Discipline yourself to make practicing part of your routine. Do you need to improve on clipping? Fitting? Setting your calf? Practice these tasks until they become natural to you.

MANAGE YOUR TIME: Stay on track by making a daily, weekly and monthly schedule and allocate all of your activities to a specific time-frame.

DON'T LACK CONFIDENT

ENCOURAGEMENT: Surround yourself with people who believe in and encourage you, or you will find it difficult to keep trying.

DON'T CELEBRATE TOO EARLY: Celebrating too early can break your stride and ruin the outcome. Celebrate after the win has been secured.
