Student Support Services

TRIO programs have been established across the U.S. to help students attend and graduate from college. Funded by the federal government, TRIO programs provide support, services, and resources to nearly one million students nationwide.

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Student Support Services is one of eight TRIO programs. The goal of this program is to help students succeed in college and graduate.

What do Student Support Services programs do?

Student Support Services programs...

- provide academic tutoring and instruction in math, writing, science, study skills, and more.
- offer advice and guidance on college course selection.
- provide information and instruction on financial and economic literacy.
- assist two-year college students who want to transfer to a four-year college.
- provide information on financial aid and help complete the FAFSA.
- offer information and assistance to students wanting to gain admission to graduate programs.
- provide career counseling.
- offer mentoring programs.

- First-generation college students from incomeeligible families
- Students with disabilities who need academic support

What are the benefits of participating in Student Support Services?

Student Support Services helps students succeed in college. Participants in SSS have been shown to earn more credits and have higher grade point averages than non-participants.

Student Support Services helps students gain important skills. In addition to academic support in subjects like math and writing, students learn important lifetime skills such as organization, time management, and networking.

Student Support Services helps build learning communities. In addition to receiving academic support, career counseling, and more, Student Support Services connects students from similar backgrounds, providing them with a support system that can last for years.
